

BREEDING CATTLE HERDSMEN AWARD

Prizes will be awarded to herdsmen and caretakers in charge of breeding cattle exhibits as a reward for their good housekeeping. The breed of cattle being shown will not enter into placing.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

A committee appointed by show management will make inspections daily to determine those who, in their judgement, do the best job of housekeeping. If, in the opinion of the judges, an exhibitor is not worthy, no prize money will be awarded.

JUDGING STANDARDS

- Orderliness and cleanliness of the stalls, animals, tack alleys and public walkways
- Personal appearance of herdsmen and helpers
- Promptness in having stalls or pens cleaned by 9:00 a.m. each day. All cattle must be in their stalls from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., except during judging and preparing animals for judging.
- Observance of all rules and regulations of the Show
- Availability of personnel to furnish information about their exhibits
- Number of animals and caretakers per exhibit with a minimum of 5 animals per exhibit
- Cooperation with other exhibitors and Show Officials

AWARDS

- 1st place – Plaque & \$100
- 2nd place – Rosette & \$75
- 3rd place – Rosette & \$50
- **Winners of the Herdsman Award will receive prime location for stalling in the Event Center for the 2024 show. “Prime location” will be at the discretion of the stalling committee.**
