DIVISION RULES

1. Each exhibitor must be a bona fide member of a 4-H Club or FFA Chapter, enrolled in elementary, secondary, or home school
2. Exhibitors must be in third grade or nine years old but under 20 years of age as of January 1, 2023
3. The order of the show is NOT subject to change
4. The Junior and Senior shows ARE separately sanctioned
5. All goats must be bona fide property of the exhibitor, continuously fed and cared for by the exhibitor from November 30 through the show dates and under the supervision of an AST, CEA or adult 4-H leader. The animal must be registered in the exhibitor's name, a sibling that is showing at RGVLS (if applicable) or family herd name on their official ADGA or AGS papers by November 30, 2022. Kids shown must have the dam registered in the exhibitor's name, a sibling that is showing at RGVLS (if applicable) or family herd name on their official ADGA or AGS papers by November 30, 2022
6. Exhibitors will not be limited to the number of entries they can enter
7. Dairy goats will not be allowed to leave grounds for nursing purposes. Such milk goats, if entered in the show, will be allowed to have kid accompany it. Exhibitors are welcome to use netting, wire, or methods to prevent kids from getting out of pens
8. At time of submitting entries any unborn babies expected between deadline and show may be registered to be shown at RGVLS by submitting an entry marked as unborn. Upon RGVLS arrival babies must be disbudded and an ADGA copy of registration receipt (printed duplicate) if the papers have not arrived in order to be eligible. Also needed is a copy of the Dams (mothers) registration papers proving the dam was registered in the exhibitor's name, a sibling that is showing at RGVLS (if applicable) or family herd name on their official ADGA or AGS papers by November 30, 2022
9. Goats entered in this division cannot be shown in the Market Goat Division
10. Fitting guidelines: Goats may be fully haired or trimmed to the owner's discretion

11. Abnormalities: Goats showing any pronounced defect, abnormality or open wounds will be barred from showing. Any evidence of cosmetic surgical alteration to enhance the physical conformation of an animal or dyeing of hair will disqualify the entry
12. Training collars may be permitted during sift or during judging at the discretion of the exhibitor's parent, 4-H leader or FFA advisor for the safety of the exhibitor
13. Goats will be shown by the age on the Registration Certificate
