## **SPECIAL RULES OPEN & YOUTH HORSE PERFORMANCE DIVISION**

1. Stallions are allowed in Ranch classes only.
2. Entry fees are non- refundable.
3. All online entries fees must be paid by the deadline. We will no longer accept payment onsite for online entries.
4. Class changes/deletions will be accepted at least two classes prior to the class you wish to add/delete. No refunds will be given for deleted classes. If a horse becomes unexpectedly ill or expires, with approval by the Show committee, a new horse may be substituted. All paperwork for the new horse must be completed prior to the start of the first class.
5. AQHA rules will apply where applicable. No tie downs, martingales, roping reins or mechanical hackamores will be allowed except in speed classes. Ranch Horse classes will follow AQHA rules. Working Cow Horse will follow SHOT rules if cattle are available.
6. Any protests must be accompanied by \$250, to be refunded if protest is validated by Show committee.
7. Walk/Trot Horse/Rider combo may not participate in lope divisions, including Ranch Horse division. The Lope Division Horse/Rider combo may not participate in Walk/Trot division.
8. Lead-Line riders may not compete in Walk/Trot, Lope or Ranch Horse divisions. Lead-Line is for ages 3-8 or children under 18 with disabilities.
9. Unruly behavior will not be tolerated by horses or humans.
10. An original negative Coggins is required for any horse entering on to the showgrounds and must be shown at time of registration/check-in.

General Rules, Regulations, and Procedures on page 23 also apply.

## **HIGH POINT AWARDS**

### **SAME HORSE/SAME RIDER RULE APPLIES**

1. You need not designate your high point horse. Points will be calculated for the horse/rider combo on all classes with the exception of non-high point classes. Halter and Color classes will NOT count towards High Point.
2. Horses need not be owned by participants. Borrowed or leased horses are allowable.
3. Performance exhibitors must compete in a minimum of 5 classes to qualify for high point. Ranch exhibitors must compete in a minimum of 4 classes to qualify for high point. You must compete in one working cow class to qualify for high point. Only one working cow horse class will count toward high point.
