

# **OPEN & YOUTH HORSE SHOW**

## **SPEED DIVISION**

**ENTRY DEADLINE** – February 15, 2024

**ENTRY FEE** - \$15 per class entered **ONLINE ENTRIES ONLY**

**STALL FEE** - \$25 per day

**RV HOOK UP** - \$25 per day

**SPEED EVENTS CHECK-IN** – 9:30 to 10:30 a.m., Saturday, March 2, 2024

**EXHIBITION** – 10 a.m. to 12 noon

**EVENT START TIME** – Promptly at 12:15 p.m.

### **SPECIAL RULES FOR OPEN & YOUTH HORSE SPEED DIVISION**

1. Stallions are allowed at the Rio Grande Valley Livestock Show ridden by an adult rider (18+ only).
2. Entry fees are non-refundable
3. All online entries fees must be paid by the deadline. We will no longer accept payment onsite for online entries.
4. All exhibitors registering onsite will only be allowed to compete in the Jackpot. For participants to be eligible for prizes, they must have entered and paid by the deadline through the online registration system.
5. There is no late fee to run in the jackpot. The jackpot entry fee will be \$25 per class. Late entries without a completed W-9 will result in forfeiture of any monetary awards.
6. Class changes/deletions will be accepted at least two classes prior to the class you wish to add/delete. No refunds will be given for deleted classes. If a horse becomes unexpectedly ill or dies, with approval by the Show committee, a new horse may be substituted. All paperwork for the new horse must be completed prior to the start of the first class.
7. AQHA rules will apply where applicable. No tie downs, martingales, roping reins or mechanical hackamores will be allowed except in speed classes. Ranch Horse Classes will follow a combination of AQHA and SHOT rules. Working Cow Horse will follow SHOT rules (if cattle are available)
8. Any protests must be accompanied by \$250, to be refunded if protest is validated by show committee
9. The two minute gate rule will be strictly adhered to, except for tack changes, which **MUST** be approved prior to the start of the Show. The participant is responsible for being at the gate ready one class prior. Rider will be lined up ready to ride during their drag. After 3<sup>rd</sup> call, rider will be scratched. Unruly behavior will not be tolerated by horse or humans
10. Points will be tabulated at the end of the show after careful analysis and confirmation. You must be present to get your awards.
11. An original negative Coggins is required for any horse entering the show grounds and must be shown at time of check-in.

### **SCHEDULE OF CLASSES**

- Class 01 – Poles Lead Line
- Class 02 – Poles (0-9yrs)
- Class 03 – Poles (10-14 yrs)

- Class 04 – Poles (15-19 yrs as long as rider is in high school)
- Class 05 – Poles (19+ yrs)
- Class 06 – Barrels Lead Line
- Class 07 – Barrels (0-9 yrs)
- Class 08 – Barrels (10-14 yrs)
- Class 09 – Barrels (15-19 yrs as long as rider is in high school)
- Class 10 – Barrels (19+ yrs)

## **HIGH POINT AWARDS**

### **SAME HORSE/SAME RIDER RULE APPLIES**

1. You need not designate your high point horse. Points will be calculated for the horse/rider combo on all classes with the exception of non-high point classes.
2. Horses need not be owned by participant. Borrowed or leased horses are allowed.
