### **Qualifications:**

- This scholarship is available to all permanent residents of Cass/Clay Counties who plan on participating in the 2022 Fair. Selections will be made after the fair for proof of participation and contribution.
- Students must be pursuing a higher education and are enrolled in a postsecondary educational institution. Applicants must provide proof of enrollment to the Red River Valley Fair Office by \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the academic year in which the scholarship is awarded.
- The scholarship is available to students who have completed at least one semester of their postsecondary education and have proof of their education commitment through a college transcript.

- Scholarship winners will be notified of their selection in early August and winners will have the opportunity to be recognized at the Big Iron Farm Show in September.
- Participants may apply yearly but are only eligible to win one scholarship annually. Preference will be given to those pursuing degrees related to Career and Technical Education (CTE).
- This scholarship is for one year only.
