MISS REDDING RODEO PAGEANT RULES & GUIDELINES

THIS COMPETITION WILL BE GOVERNED BY THE FOLLOWING MISS REDDING RODEO CONTEST RULES & GUIDELINES:

1. The Miss Redding Rodeo Committee and the Redding Rodeo Association Board of Directors have the authority to make provisions and waive eligibility, rules and/or guidelines.
2. To be eligible to compete all contestants must have a completed entry form including a signed expectations agreement and liability waiver.
3. Contestants for Miss Redding Rodeo must be between the age of 17 and 24. A birth certificate may be required at the first contestant's meeting.
4. Contestants must live in Northern California for a minimum of one year prior to 01-01-2023. Exception's may be made on a case by case basis by Committee for out of county contestants.
5. Contestants must be single and never entered into a marriage contract that was annulled; never been divorced, pregnant, or the mother of a child.
6. Contestants must be of good moral character and never been convicted of a misdemeanor or a felony.
7. Contestants may not compete for Miss Redding Rodeo if currently holding another title.
8. Miss Redding Rodeo or the 1st Runner-up may not compete for any other title during her reign.
9. The Expectation Statement shall be a part of these Rules and Guidelines.
10. The Redding Rodeo Association (RRA) will be released from any liability that might result from participating in this contest, including activities and trips in connection therewith.
11. Miss Redding Rodeo and the 1st Runner-up must each have their own horse and transportation available to them at all times for the following parades and rodeos: Red Bluff, Cottonwood, Redding Rodeo Parade and all performances of the Redding Rodeo.
12. Miss Redding Rodeo and her court are invited to appear at various functions and activities to promote both the City of Redding and the Redding Rodeo Association.
13. Contestants will appear in parade attire (hat, boots, long sleeved western blouse, etc., no chaps) for the following:
 - a. Personal Interviews
 - b. Horsemanship Competition
14. The contestants will appear in a parade attire outfit and one dressy western (hat, boots, dress or skirt) at the Miss Redding Rodeo coronation on October 21, 2023 for the final judging and crowning of "Miss Redding Rodeo 2024".
15. Contest judging will be based on the categories of Horsemanship, Appearance, Poise and Personality.
16. A judge may not be approached by any individual with the intent to influence or harass. This act may result in disqualification. All judges' decisions are final.
17. Grievances must come directly from the contestant and reported only to the Miss Redding Rodeo Committee Chairman or a Committee Member. Grievances must be reported within one (1) hour of the completion of that portion of the competition.
18. The young lady who is chosen as Miss Redding Rodeo 2024 will be eligible to compete for the title of Miss Rodeo California after successfully completing her reign.

Subsequent to the Miss Redding Rodeo Pageant, any contestant being awarded the title of Miss Redding Rodeo and/or otherwise becoming the successor thereto, or a member of the court, shall adhere to these Rules and Guidelines throughout her reign.

Upon the occurrence of any infraction of the Rules and Guidelines, the title of Miss Redding Rodeo 2024 or the 1st Runner-up, together with any and all the benefits derived by such person, shall be forfeited to the next qualified contestant.

EXPECTATION STATEMENT

I understand that if I win the title of Miss Redding Rodeo or 1st Runner up, I will be the representative for the Redding Rodeo Association (RRA) and will promote the sport of rodeo and horsemanship. I will portray personal characteristics of high moral and ethical nature and exhibit humane treatment to animals.

I will abide by the Rules and Guidelines of the Miss Redding Rodeo competition.

If chosen Miss Redding Rodeo or 1st Runner up I will:

- a. Sign a contract with the Redding Rodeo Association agreeing to abide by and uphold the duties and responsibilities of the title of Miss Redding Rodeo or 1st Runner up as outlined in the Expectation Statement, Rules and Guidelines, copies of which I have received.
- b. Appear, whenever possible, when I am asked by the President of Redding Rodeo Association and/or Miss Redding Rodeo Committee Chairman to attend event to promote the Redding Rodeo and the City of Redding.
- c. Wear my banner, crown and proper western attire as outlined by the Miss Redding Rodeo Committee whenever I make an appearance as Miss Redding Rodeo or 1st Runner up.
- d. Uphold the title of Miss Redding Rodeo or 1st Runner up and fulfill the provisions of my reign.

I agree that during my reign, I shall observe and exhibit, at all times a high standard of moral and ethical behavior befitting my title and will strive to set a good example to the public, to future competitors, and to the members of the Redding Rodeo Association.

I understand that all of my appearances as Miss Redding Rodeo or 1st Runner up are to be approved by the Miss Redding Rodeo Committee.

I understand and agree that if I am crowned Miss Redding Rodeo, the Miss Redding Rodeo saddle and buckle will remain property of the Redding Rodeo Association. At the conclusion of my reign as Miss Redding Rodeo, all of the awards, including the saddle and buckle shall permanently be awarded to me, if at the determination of the Miss Redding Rodeo Committee, I, as Miss Redding Rodeo, have satisfactorily performed and completed all the duties and obligations of my contract.

Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement **(Read Carefully Before Signing)**

In consideration of being permitted to participate or volunteer in any way in Redding Rodeo activities, and/or being permitted to enter for any purpose any restricted area (here in defined as any area where in admittance to the general public is prohibited), participant shall:

1. To inspect the facilities, areas and equipment to be used, and if he or she believes anything is unsafe, the participant should immediately advise the officials of such condition and refuse to participate. I understand and agree that, if at any time, I feel anything to be UNSAFE; I will immediately take all precautions to avoid the unsafe area and REFUSE TO PARTICIPATE further.
2. I/WE fully understand and acknowledge that:
 - (a) There are risks and dangers associated with participation in Redding Rodeo activities which could result in bodily injury partial and/or total disability, paralysis and death.
 - (b) The social and economic losses and/or damages, which could result from these risks and dangers described above, could be severe.
 - (c) These risks and dangers may be caused by the action, inaction or negligence of the participant or the action, inaction or negligence of others, including, but not limited to, the Releases named below.
 - (d) There may be other risks not known or are not reasonably foreseeable at his time.

I/WE accept and assume such risks and responsibility for the losses and/or damages following such injury, disability, paralysis or death, however caused and whether caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releases named below.

3. I/WE HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE REDDING RODEO, THE CITY OF REDDING, THE FRIENDS OF REDDING RODEO, ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, AGENTS, SUBCONTRACTORS AND ASSIGNS (herein referred to as Releasees) for any cause relating to participation and/or volunteering in Redding Rodeo activities. Furthermore I/WE RELEASE FROM ALL LIABILITY TO THE UNDERSIGNED, my/our personal representatives, assigns, executors, heirs and next to kin FOR ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES OR DAMAGES AND ANY CLAIMS OR DEMANDS THEREFORE ON ACCOUNT OF ANY INJURY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE DEATH OF THE PARTICIPANT AND/OR VOLUNTEER OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY, ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THE REDDING RODEO EVENT(S) CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEE OR OTHERWISE.



LIABILITY WAIVER (CONTINUED)

4. EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of California and that if any portion is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding continue in full legal force and effect.

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE, OR GUARANTEE BEING MADE TO ME AND INTEND MY SIGNATURE TO BE COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW.
