Eligibility:

1. Graduating Senior from any high school in Shasta County.
2. Applications must be received by April 1st of the current school year.

Scholarship Committee:

1. The Redding Rodeo Scholarship Committee will review all applications
2. Finalists chosen from the applications will be invited to a formal interview, further information to follow.

Scholarship Judging:

1. Some of the items to be considered when reviewing applications:
 - a. Family member affiliated with the Redding Rodeo Association or any affiliate group.
 - b. Volunteering for Redding Rodeo or related groups.
 - c. Active participation in Future Farmers of America.
 - d. Active participation in California High School Rodeo, District 1.
 - e. Active participation in 4-H club work.
 - f. Seniors who have achieved a 3.5 or greater GPA.
 - g. During the interview, each finalist will be asked about plans for college, degree major, financial need, community involvement, formal and extracurricular school activities, and clubs and other organizations to which they belong.

Scholarship Award:

1. At minimum (one) \$1000 scholarship will be awarded, the committee reserves the right to award additional scholarships.
2. The scholarship(s) will be presented at the recipient's high school's Awards Assembly.
3. An envelope containing instructions for the scholarship recipients to verify their enrollment in the college of their choice will be given.
