SPECIAL RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Dairy Goat show is open to all dehorned does.
2. All does 24 months or older must have freshened at least once.
3. Entries are limited to no more than ten (10) animals per exhibitor.
4. Registration papers MUST be checked 24 hours prior to the show.
5. The American Dairy Goat Association, American Dairy Goat Society or other recognized Goat association (not Meat Breeds) issued registration certificates for purebred animals only.
6. A permanent ear tag or tattoo is required.
7. ADGA Rules apply.
