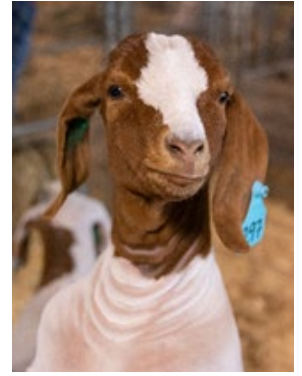

2. First-place winner in all showmanship divisions will compete for MASTER SHOWMAN.
3. Contestants will not show their own animals.
4. Contestants are required to wear the uniform of the organization they represent.
5. Minis do not compete.
6. Contestants will report to the show ring for check-in at 3:30 pm on Friday, February 20.



# MARKET GOAT

## SPECIAL RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Market goats must show kid teeth.
2. After Weigh-in, market goats will be classified according to weight for judging purposes.
3. If animals grade for auction, the maximum pay weight will be adjusted to 120 pounds.
4. No muzzles allowed.
5. **MUST BE DEHORND OR BE BLUNT CUT AND FLAT NO LONGER THAN 1"**
6. U.S.D.A. CHEVON GRADES:
  - MARKET READY:** USDA Prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .08-.12 most desirable, .13-.22 back fat acceptable, an average of greater conformation and cutability.
  - NOT MARKET READY:** Good or lower quality grade with 12th rib back fat range <.08 or >.22: under-finished goats grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cut ability.
