

# 2021 Swine Department Schedule of Events

The 2021 Barrow Show is a NON-TERMINAL show. As outlined in the WI DATCP rules for non-terminal swine shows, ALL swine coming to the fair MUST have a PRRS and PEDv test of the herd of origin within 90 days of the exhibition. Include test date, test type, and test results on the CVI (health paper).

Exhibitors MUST have health papers, proof of completed PRRS and PEDv testing on their health papers, AND drug affidavits for unloading on Monday. NO EXCEPTIONS!

ALL light and heavy weight barrows will be released back HOME on Sunday at 9:00 PM.
