

Rock County Barn Quilt Contest

Guidelines:

- Quilts must be painted on exterior wood (MDO recommended).
- Quilts must be square. Minimum size: 2'x2'. Maximum size: 4'x4'.
- Quilts must be painted with a quality exterior latex paint (3+ coats).
- Quilts must be an actual quilt block (not a "painting"). Please provide quilt block name on back of barn quilt w/permanent marker (i.e. "Rising Star", "Flying Geese", "Farmer's Daughter", et al).
- Quilts must be primed on all sides (including back).
- Quilt colors must extend over edges on all sides.
- Exhibitor name must be printed in permanent marker on the back.
- All barn quilts will be displayed the *full duration* of the Rock County 4-H Fair (possibly outdoors).

Entry instructions:

- Open to all adults and youth (14 and older)
- Entry time: Monday, July 25 (3-6 PM)
- Please bring barn quilts to the BLOCK building on the fairgrounds (*Please enter via Gate 1. All barn quilts must be entered/delivered no later than 6 PM Monday, July 25, 2022.*)

Judging: Tuesday, July 26, 2022 – 9 AM – Block Building

- Difficulty (was an intricate process of painting the quilt) - 30 %
- Accuracy (reflects a true quilt block- precision/ design) - 30 %
- Eye Appeal (overall finished appearance, color combo, etc) - 40 %

Premiums: 1st place: \$50, 2nd place: \$30, 3rd place: \$20

Note: If enough entries are received, the quilts will be divided into two classes (i.e. 2'x2' quilts and 4'x4' quilts) and premiums will be awarded in both classes.
