The Rock County 4-H Fair is committed to creating a safe, comfortable, and enjoyable entertainment experience. All guests are expected to follow the below guidelines and should expect an environment where:

- Guests shall be treated in a consistent, professional, and courteous manner by all Rock County Fair personnel.
- Guests shall wear appropriate attire at all times, including shoes and shirts, and there shall not be any obscene or indecent messages on clothing.
- Guests shall consume alcoholic beverages in designated areas in a responsible manner. Intervention with an impaired, intoxicated, or underage guest, shall be handled in a prompt and safe manner.
- Guests shall enjoy the Fair free from disruptive behavior, including foul or offensive language or obscene gestures.
- Guests shall not engage in activities that could endanger others, including but not limited to fighting, engaging in intimidating, disorderly or disruptive behavior. Guests who engage in any of these actions shall immediately be ejected from the Fairgrounds.
- Smoking, e-cigarettes, or vaping is prohibited inside all Fairgrounds buildings, barns, tents, and within eight (8) feet of any building entrance.
- Guests shall comply with requests from Rock County Fair staff regarding operations and emergency response procedures.
- Weapons of any kind or objects that appear to be weapons (toy blasters, squirt guns, etc.) are prohibited on the Rock County Fair Grounds.
- Bicycle riding, skateboarding, rollerblading, skating, or recreational scooters are prohibited on the grounds.
- Blocking of any building, booth, exhibit, concession stand, performance, ticket window, gate, stage, doorway, walkway, fire exit, or stairway, as to impede access is prohibited.
- Rock County Fair is not responsible and assumes no liability arising from fire, theft, damage to or loss of vehicle or an article left inside the vehicle for persons parked on the fairgrounds. Please lock your vehicle.
- The Rock County Fair reserves the right to remove any displays or items that could be considered objectionable or offensive to fellow guests.

Guests are encouraged to report any inappropriate behavior to the nearest staff member.

Guests who choose not to adhere to these provisions shall be subject to ejection without a refund, liability, or compensation and may also be in violation of state law or city ordinances resulting in possible arrest and/or prosecution.
