

# Junior Homemaking Rockingham County Fair

2022 RULES AND REGULATIONS  
(updated info Aug. 6, 2022)

Open to all youth  
(ages 4-19 as of January 1, 2022)  
living in Rockingham County, VA,  
one of its towns, or the  
City of Harrisonburg, VA

- **All exhibits - except baked goods - must be brought in from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Sunday, August 14. Only baked goods may be brought in on Monday, August 15, from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.** Absolutely nothing other than baked goods will be accepted on Monday. Judging will be from 9:30 a.m. to Noon on Monday. Place Ribbons will be displayed by 6:00 p.m. Monday. Sweepstakes winners will be announced on Tuesday.

- EXHIBITS ENTERED SHOULD NOT HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY EXHIBITED AND ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE MADE BY THE EXHIBITOR. **Only one exhibit per class number per person permitted.** The department and fair management will not be responsible for articles exhibited. **Pick up items on Sunday, August 21, between 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. only.** Having your claim check and claiming the item in-person will make the process go quickly.

- When there is no competition in a class, the judges reserve the right to award a ribbon if the item is worthy or, if it is not worthy, no prize will be awarded. When there more than 10 entries in a class, the judges have the option to award two sets of ribbons. Premiums this year will be  
**\$4 for blue ribbons (first place)**  
**\$3 for red ribbons (second place) and**  
**\$2 for white ribbons (third place)**

- **PLEASE NOTE: Everything is NEW and we will be using the Class Numbers posted in FAIRENTRY as the official numbers.** (Not the pdf on the website; not what was printed in the paper.)

## **SWEEPSTAKES ARE BEING AWARDED!!**

### RULES for Sweepstakes Eligibility:

An OVERALL SWEEPSTAKES ribbon & premium will be awarded to one youth 9-13, and one youth 14-19 who receives the most blue ribbons in their age division **AND has entered at least 3 items in each of at least three of the six sections in Junior Homemaking,**

An overall sweepstakes ribbon and premium will be awarded to one child ages 4-8 **who has entered two of the six sections.**

**Mt Crawford Creamery** generously provides the Overall Sweepstakes premiums:

- \$200 to the 14 – 19 division winner,
- \$100 to the 9 – 13 division winner, and
- \$35 to the 4 – 8 division winner.

*Note: Exhibitors are not eligible to receive this award but once in 3 years (not counting 2020 Covid year).a). Once in three years applies to changing age groups as well.)*

**SWEEPSTAKES AWARDS each Section (I,II,III,IV,V&VI)** in Junior Homemaking. These may be won more than once.
