Section 1 - Contact Information

- Provide your name as it appears on your transcript AND your preferred daily use name where indicated on the form.
- Provide parent or guardian contact information – must submit at least one contact

Section 2 - Education Information

- Current High School
- When do you expect to graduate?
- What are your higher education plans
- What are your career plans?
- What is your current unweighted GPA?
 - You must choose one of the three options listed.
 - If your current unweighted GPA is between 2.75 and 3.0 you will be asked to complete a separate variance form with your school contact.
 - Applicants with a GPA below 2.75, as provided by your school, are not eligible to apply.

Section 3 - Biography Form

- When is your birthday?
- Where were you born? (Past Rose Festival Princesses have been born in countries all over the world!)
- Why do you want to represent your school and community as a Court Member? (100 words or less)
- In your spare time, what hobbies, special interests or activities do you engage in?
- What is a favorite place to visit in Portland and why?
- Please list any school related activities, awards or recognitions.
- What are you most proud of during your high school career to date?
- What is your favorite Rose Festival event and why?

Section 4 - Volunteer Service

- Please provide a minimum of 20 hours of volunteer service that you have performed during your high school career, listing the organization, a contact name and number, the number of hours, and a description of the activity.
