




PORTLAND ROSE FESTIVAL FOUNDATION FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

Unforeseen challenges in 2020 took a financial toll on many businesses and non-profit organizations. Thanks to steadfast leadership, difficult decisions, earnest expense reduction, and philanthropic generosity, the Portland Rose Festival's overall losses remained under the half-million dollar loss we were expecting this fiscal year. While a \$421,183 loss is significant, support from sponsors, donors, and government CARES Act funds (specifically the Paycheck Protection Program or PPP) has helped us to "keep the lights on" and maintain basic operations to weather the worst "storm" we've faced in a century. A silver lining in those storm clouds is the fact that, with stringent cash management, we have not yet needed to deplete our reserves - our "rainy day fund" - with a balance of \$640,394. The stormy days continue, and uncertainty remains about when we can get back to producing large scale in-person events. The Portland Rose Festival Foundation WILL persevere by properly stewarding resources and funds, and will be here, as it has for over 100 years, to serve the community when it is safe to do so.


2020 ROSE FESTIVAL REVENUE: \$1,629,159
