

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 24-6-402 (2) (c) requires each public body to designate the public place or places where notices of meetings of the local public body will be posted annually at its first regular meeting of the year; and
WHEREAS, the first regular meeting of the Routt County Fair Advisory Board in 2021 took place on

b. The bulletin board located outside the Commissioners' Office, located on the second floor of the Routt County Courthouse, 522 Lincoln Avenue, Steamboat Springs, Colorado.

FAIR ADVISORY BOARD CODE OF CONDUCT

BOARD MEMBERS

BOARD MEETING ATTENDANCE

Purpose

This policy is intended to support full contribution of all board members. All board members receive a copy of this official policy. The policy is reviewed once a year. The policy has been reviewed and authorized by the board (see signature and date below).

Definition of a Board Attendance Problem

A board attendance problem exists with any of the following conditions:

- 1. The member has two un-notified absences ("un-notified" means the member did not contact the Fair Coordinator at least <u>24-hours</u> prior to the meeting to indicate their anticipated absence);
- 2. The member has three notified absences;
- 3. The member misses one third of the total number of board meetings in a twelve-month period;

Response to a Board Attendance Problem

If a board attendance problem exists, the Board Chair will promptly contact the member to discuss the problem. The member's response will promptly be shared with the entire board at the next board meeting. At that meeting, the board will decide what actions to take regarding the board member's continued membership on the board.

If the board decides to recommend termination of membership to the Routt County Board of County Commissioners, termination will be conducted per Routt County Resolution 2010-004.

ACTIVE PARTICIPATION

Board members are expected to exercise the duties and responsibilities of their positions with integrity, collegiality, and care. This includes:

- 1. Making attendance at all meetings of the board a high priority.
- 2. Making punctuality at all meetings, activities and events a high priority.
- 3. Being prepared to discuss the issues and business on the agenda, and having read all background material relevant to the topics at hand.
- 4. Cooperating with and respecting the opinions of fellow Board members, and leaving personal prejudices out of all board discussions, as well as supporting actions of the Board even when the Board member personally did not support the action taken.
- 5. Putting the interests of the organization above personal interests.
- 6. Representing the organization in a positive and supportive manner at all times and in all places.
- 7. Showing respect and courteous conduct in all board and committee meetings and when acting in the capacity as a Fair Advisory Board Member.
- 8. Refraining from intruding on administrative issues that are the responsibility of management, except to monitor the results and ensure that procedures are consistent with board policy.
- 9. Observing established lines of communication and directing requests for information or assistance to the Fairgrounds Manager/Fair Coordinator.

ACTIONS AND BEHAVIOR

- 1. The Board expects of itself and its members ethical and business-like conduct. This commitment includes proper use of authority and appropriate decorum in group and individual behavior when acting as Board members.
- 2. Board members must avoid any conflict of interest with respect to their fiduciary responsibility.

- 3. I support the purpose of the organization and pledge my commitment to assist in carrying out its work.
- 4. As a board member, I will consistently act responsibly and prudently. I understand my duties to include: legal, fiscal and moral responsibility, along with my fellow board members, for the well-being of this organization. As such, it is my responsibility to:
 - a. Be familiar with our budget and take an active part in the budget planning process.
 - b. Know and approve all policies and programs and oversee their implementation.
 - c. Take responsibility for making decisions on organization issues and board matters.
 - d. Keep up-to-date on the business of the organization.
 - e. Excuse myself from discussions, decisions and votes where I may have a conflict of interest.
 - f. Actively participate in all fundraising activities.

Should I fail to fulfill these commitments to the organization, I understand that an officer of the Board will call upon me to discuss my responsibilities. Should there come a time where I am no longer able to fulfill my obligations to the organization, it will be my responsibility to resign my position as a member of the Board.

ORGANIZATION

As a board member, I understand that the organization will be responsible to me in the following ways:

By my signature, I acknowledge that I have read, understand, and agree to the above policy.

- 1. I expect that I will have information about programs, policies, goals and objectives as appropriate.
- 2. Opportunities will be provided for me to discuss the organization's programs, goals, activities and status with the Fairgrounds Manager/Fair Coordinator and the Board President.
- 3. It is expected that board members and the Fairgrounds Manager/Fair Coordinator will respond in a straightforward fashion to questions that I feel are necessary to carry out my fiscal, legal and moral responsibilities to the organization.
- 4. Board members and the Fairgrounds Manager/Fair Coordinator will work in good faith with me towards achievement of our goals.
- 5. If the organization does not fulfill its commitments to me, I may call upon the Board President and Fairgrounds Manager/Fair Coordinator to discuss the organization's responsibilities to me.
- 6. When performing its responsibilities in accordance with Routt County resolution 2010-004, the Fair Advisory Board and its members shall be covered in accordance with County's liability insurance coverage.


