Dear High School Educator,

We are excited to announce the 2023 San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Western Art Contest will be held the weekend of December 2nd –4th , 2022 . The Western Art Contest is a unique opportunity for high school students to earn college scholarships through art from the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo.

Students will enter their artwork to be judged in one of the following 12 classes/categories:

3D-Clay	2D-Oil/Acrylic Painting	2D-Graphite/Pencil/Charcoal Drawing
3D-Other Medium	2D-Watercolor Painting	2D-Pen/Ink Drawing
2D-Digital Art (NEW)	2D-Mixed Media Painting 2	D-Pastel/Chalk Drawing
2D-Other Medium (NEW)	2D- Mixed Media Drawing	2D-Colored Pencil/Conte Drawing

The following scholarships will be awarded:

- Twelve \$10,000 scholarships – One to each student with entry judged “Champion” in each class/category
- There will be an additional \$5,000 add on scholarship for the Class/Category Champion above judged “Best of Show”

This is a total of \$125,000 in scholarships for our Top 12 Western Art Contest Winners (some restrictions apply per contest Rules and Regulations).

The Briscoe Western Art Museum, in partnership with the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo, will be exhibiting the Top 12 works of art throughout the month of January 2023. The exposure these young artists receive by having their artwork displayed is invaluable. The artwork will then be moved to the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo grounds to be exhibited during the event, February 9-26, 2023.

The contest is open to high school students in South Central Texas that are currently enrolled in an accredited public, private or home school environment. Students must be U.S. citizens and Texas residents. Please see the attached lists of eligible School Districts and Counties. We hope that your students will participate.

The documents for the 2023 San Antonio Show & Rodeo Western Art Contest, being held in December 2022, are available on our website at sarodeo.com/westernart.

Please note the following dates for this year’s contest, held in the Auction Barn (located on Freeman Blvd., at the Freeman Coliseum/AT&T Center grounds):

- Friday, December 2nd - Noon to 7 p.m. - Check-In: All artwork, with entry forms attached, must be dropped off
- Saturday, December 3rd - Judging: Students, parents, and teachers are not allowed to be present during the judging
- Sunday, December 4th
  - 1:30 p.m. - Mentor meeting for Top 12 students and parents to complete paperwork take photos and ask questions
  - 2:00 p.m.- 3:30 p.m. – Scholarship Presentation Program and Reception for students, parents, teachers, family, and friends to view all entries and watch scholarship awards presentation.
  - 3:30 p.m. - Check-out: Artwork not judged in Top 12 will be returned to teachers and students at this time

Students and their teachers will be notified by phone on the evening of December 3rd if artwork is one of the Top 12. Contact information on the “Contest Release Agreement” must be complete and accurate.
