I. Junior Show General Information

Junior Show Entry: Entries are not considered complete unless they have been submitted online <u>and</u> paid by credit card or check postmarked on or before THURSDAY, December 1, 2022. Incomplete entries (entries either not submitted online or no credit card payment made or check not postmarked by December 1, 2022) will be assessed an additional 10% fee. <u>Checks will only be accepted from a Club/Chapter Account, Cashier's Check or Money Order. No personal checks will be accepted.</u>

- i. Late Entries: For any Junior Show entries submitted online and credit card payment or check postmarked from December 2-15, 2022, all standard entry fees will be doubled, if accepted.
- ii. Past Due Entries: For any Junior Show entries received from December 16, 2022, until the end of check-in for the respective show or contest, a past due entry fee of \$250 per entry will be assessed, if accepted.

Quality Counts: To be eligible to compete in the Junior Breeding, Junior Commercial and/or Junior Market Shows, exhibitors will need Quality Counts verification. The Quality Counts verification number must be recorded on the online entry when entering the project. Please refer to the website https://agrilife.org/qualitycounts/ for information on how to become verified.

Breeding Show Ownership Deadlines:

Registration Certificates will be used to verify ownership date for breeding animals with the exception of Crossbred Gilts, Commercial Ewes and Commercial Does. Animals must be registered in the Herdbook of their Association in only the name of the Junior owner(s) on or before the required ownership date (see below). Registration Certificates must state the name of the Junior owner(s) only. Registration Certificates that list any additional names besides the name(s) the entry is validated under will be disqualified. Registration Certificates must be available upon request.

Purchase, delivery, possession, transfer, and registration must all take place on or before the required ownership date. Original Registration Certificates must be available during the show at all times.

Registered Sheep, Boer Breeding Goat: October 1, 2022 (Must be validated through Breeding Sheep or Breeding Goat Validation, respectively, on or before October 31, 2022) Note* Family validation is now allowed for breeding sheep and goats. Commercial Ewes, Commercial Does: October 31, 2022 (Must be validated through Breeding Sheep or Breeding Goat Validation, respectively, on or before October 31, 2022)

Angora Breeding Goat, Dairy Heifers, Beef Breeding Heifers: November 1, 2022 (Beef Breeding Heifers must complete all phases of heifer validation through the Texas 4-H & FFA Breeding Heifer Validation Program on or before November 8, 2022)

Significant Changes and Updates for 2023

- Premium List to be released October 1, 2022 Please read and if you have any questions, contact us.
- NOTE: There will be no RV Campers/ Trailers allowed onto Salado Creek Property.
- All Contests with the exception of Western Art will be allowed to be entered by CTE/STEM Programs statewide. All livestock shows and calf scramble will remain 4-H/FFA members only.
- Junior Show Entries will increase \$5/animal.
- Handling fee will be \$10 per Club/Chapter and individual Open Show Entries
 - o All passes for Junior Show will be mailed to the respective County/Chapter/CTE or STEM Program.
- All Premium Passes <u>must</u> be purchased during the ONLINE ENTRY PROCESS. Closes December 15th, 2022.
- **Bedding:** NO OUTSIDE BEDDING WILL BE ALLOWED. All bedding will be provided by the show. The use of artificial grass mats and carpets are prohibited as bedding in all barns. Straw/hay bedding is prohibited in beef cattle stalls. Insofar as possible, appropriate types of bedding will be available for sale on the Grounds at the FEED STORE. Discretion as to what constitutes acceptable bedding is held exclusively by Show Management.
 - o Premium Shavings (Champion Shavings) will be provided and additional bags available for purchase.
 - o Shavings, Pellets and Straw will be available. Cedar fiber will still be used for Angora goats.
- REMINDER: If you want to stall together, you must arrive at Salado Creek Property together.
- Unloading: In order to expedite the unloading process, exhibitors are asked to follow all directions related to arrival at SCP and Grounds. Once on Grounds, exhibitors must follow unloading directions by volunteers and security. Any resistance or failure to follow instructions by the driver will make any animals on that trailer subject to disqualification. Exhibitors taking an excessive amount of time to unload will be warned and given a deadline to complete unloading. Those failing to meet the deadline may be subject to removal by tow truck at the discretion of SALE staff and volunteer committee leadership at the vehicle owner's expense.
- There will be no pre-stalling for market lambs and goats.
- Exhibitor Campgrounds: Campground space will be extremely limited for most shows. Parents, CEAs, ASTs, adult leaders or their representatives are asked to assist in reducing the number of chairs from their respective county or chapter. No tables will be permitted to be set up in the Livestock Barns. Nothing will be allowed to be set up in designated Fire Lanes. Exhibitors must be aware of their surroundings and cognizant of others when making space for their campgrounds. Exhibitors abusing campground areas will be subject to disqualification.
