UPDATES & REMINDERS

I. Junior Show General Information

Junior Show Entry: Entries are not considered complete unless they have been submitted online <u>and</u> credit card payment or check received on or before FRIDAY, December 1, 2023. Incomplete entries (entries either not submitted online or credit card payment or check not received by December 1, 2023) will be assessed an additional 10% fee.

i. Late Entries: For any Junior Show entries submitted online and credit card payment or check received from December 2-15, 2023, all standard entry fees will be doubled, if accepted.

ii. Past Due Entries: For any Junior Show entries with payment postmarked or received from December 16, 2023, until the end of check-in for the respective show or contest, a late entry fee of \$250 per entry will be assessed, if accepted.

Quality Counts: To be eligible to compete in the Junior Breeding, Junior Commercial and/or Junior Market Shows, exhibitors will need Quality Counts verification. The Quality Counts verification number must be recorded on the online entry when entering the project. Please refer to the website https://agrilife.org/qualitycounts/ for information on how to become verified.

Breeding Show Ownership Deadlines:

Registration Certificates will be used to verify ownership date for breeding animals with the exception of Crossbred Gilts, Commercial Ewes and Commercial Does. Animals must be registered in the Herdbook of their Association in only the name of the Junior owner(s) on or before the required ownership date (see below). Registration Certificates must state the name of the Junior owner(s) only. Registration Certificates that list any additional names besides the name(s) the entry is validated under will be disqualified. Registration Certificates must be available upon request.

Purchase, delivery, possession, transfer, and registration must all take place on or before the required ownership date. Original Registration Certificates must be available during the show at all times.

Registered Sheep, Boer Breeding Goat: October 1, 2023 (Must be validated through Breeding Sheep or Breeding Goat Validation, respectively, on or before October 31, 2023) Note* Family validation is now allowed for breeding sheep and goats. Visit www.sheepandgoatvalidation.tamu.edu for complete validation guidelines.

Commercial Ewes, Commercial Does: October 31, 2023 (Must be validated through Breeding Sheep or Breeding Goat Validation, respectively, on or before October 31, 2023)

Angora Breeding Goat, Dairy Heifers, Beef Breeding Heifers: November 1, 2023 (Beef Breeding Heifers must complete all phases of heifer validation through the Texas 4-H & FFA Breeding Heifer Validation Program on or before November 1, 2023. All Registration Papers must be uploaded by November 8, 2023.)

Breeding Swine, Crossbred Gilts: December 1, 2023 (Must complete all phases of gilt validation through the Texas 4-H & FFA Breeding Gilt Validation Program on or before December 1, 2023)

All Registration Papers for Purebred Gilts must be uploaded by January 2, 2024.

Significant Changes and Updates for 2024

• Premium List to be released October 1, 2023 – Please read and if you have any questions, contact us.

• REMINDERS:

- o **Bedding:** NO OUTSIDE BEDDING WILL BE ALLOWED.
 - NO cedar fiber allowed to be used in the Cattle Barn.
 - ➤ Shredded cardboard and cedar fiber will still be used for Angora goats.
- o If you want to stall together, you must arrive at Salado Creek Property together.
- o There will be no pre-stalling for market lambs and goats.
- Exhibitor Campgrounds: Campground space will be extremely limited for most shows. Parents, CEAs, ASTs, adult leaders or their representatives are asked to assist in reducing the number of chairs from their respective county or chapter. No tables will be permitted to be set up in the Livestock Barns. Nothing will be allowed to be set up in designated Fire Lanes. Exhibitors must be aware of their surroundings and cognizant of others when making space for their campgrounds. Exhibitors abusing campground areas will be subject to disqualification.
- o SCHEDULE There are a few changes. Check it out.

GILTS –

- All Purebred gilts must have been farrowed between <u>June</u> 1 (not July) and September 15, 2023 inclusive. In 2024, Purebred gilt classes will be broken and shown by <u>weight</u>. Range: 200 350 lbs with 15-lb weigh-back.
- o The Crossbred Gilts will follow this same weight range of 200 350 lbs with a 15-lb weigh back.
- o We will add <u>Hereford</u> gilts to our 2024 Junior Purebred Breeding Gilt Show. We would like to get an idea of how popular this breed may be in our show, but we do not want to prevent anyone from bringing two gilts of breeds currently eligible for scholarships. Therefore, we will allow exhibitors to enter a maximum of three (3) head in the Junior Purebred Gilt Show, BUT AT LEAST ONE (1) AND NO MORE THAN TWO (2) MUST BE A HEREFORD GILT. This will be enforced at Check-in. If anyone is found violating this rule, ALL entries will be disqualified. Hereford Gilts will not be eligible for a scholarship in 2024, but Premiums will be awarded.
- o Additionally, we will be working with the swine registries to DNA test, at minimum, Breed and Reserve Breed Champions in the Purebred Gilt Show.

ANGORA GOATS –

- o Angora Goats will show on Sunday, February 11th @ 8 am
- o Bucks (Kid, Yearling, Aged) will be allowed to enter.

BREEDING HEIFERS –

- o Split Hereford/Polled Hereford Heifers & Grey/Red Brahman Heifers Scholarships offered to each breed.
- o Any Simbrah heifers designated "*Simbrah" will be required to be shown in the ARB classes.
- MARKET TURKEY TOMS Top 15 Market Turkey Toms will be sold in the Junior Livestock Auction
- MARKET STEERS Split Hereford/Polled Hereford Steers (3 classes each; Herefords 1st 3rd & Polled Herefords 1st 2nd make the Junior Livestock Auction)
- **COMMERCIAL STEERS** Initial Weight: Aug. 26 Sept. 1 & Final Weight: Jan. 26 Feb. 1; Record Books must be mailed by UPS/FedEx and posted by February 3, 2024.

- o All Premium Passes <u>must</u> be purchased during the ONLINE ENTRY PROCESS. Closes December 15th, 2023.

• ALL SHEEP & GOAT SHOWS (BREEDING/COMMERCIAL & MARKET)

- Free-standing head-stanchions and fitting mats of any kind will ONLY be allowed to be set up inside of the pens.
- o Pens will not be taken apart or altered in any way without Superintendent approval. Any approved alterations, must be back in original place before departure.
- **CATTLE STALLS** Front and end panels may be covered, but there will be no panels or covering behind the cattle without Superintendent approval.
- **GOAT/SHEEP/SWINE PENS** Pens may be lined on 3 sides at panel height only. Nothing may cover the gate or over the pen.
- **SCRAPIE TAGS** No scrapie tags will be allowed in any market lambs or goats. Only the Texas Validation and TLBA/TGBA tag will be allowed in the ear of Market Lambs & Goats. All other tags will be removed. If the Scrapie tag is removed, it will be linked to the Texas Validation tag number by agreement with Texas Animal Health Commission and Texas Lamb & Goat Validation.
- **JUNIOR AG MECHANICS** Welding Contest will be added in 2024. More details to come.
- **JUNIOR SHOOT-OUT** Entry Fee increase American Trap & American Trap Doubles \$125 each; Sporting Clays \$150
- **NEW ITEMS** Cattle Barn will have all new bleachers in 2024.
- ENTRY SYSTEM Please make sure all information is updated for your exhibitors prior to Sept 1, 2023 or those exhibitors will be removed from the entry system.
- **PARKING PASSES** LS1/LS2 Parking Pass fee increase
 - Open Show Exhibitors: Each exhibitor may purchase up to three Parking Passes for the week they are showing. Week 1 Parking Passes may be purchased at time of entry through the Competitive Events Entry System ONLY.
 - <u>Junior Show Exhibitors</u>: Each exhibitor may purchase <u>one</u> Parking Pass for each week they are showing. Week 1 and/or Week 2 Parking Passes may be purchased at time of entry through the Competitive Events Entry System ONLY.
 - <u>Club/Chapters:</u> Each Club/Chapter will be issued <u>one</u> free Parking Pass valid for each week exhibitors are showing for the AST/CEA or CTE/STEM Director to supervise projects. Each Club/Chapter will have the option to purchase up to three additional Parking Passes per week for additional AST/CEA or CTE/STEM Directors who will be supervising projects. Each judging team will receive <u>one</u> (1) free Day Parking Pass valid for date of contest.

- JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION (MARKET LAMBS & BARROWS) The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo has been working to reduce the time required for the Junior Market Lamb and Barrow Auctions. These auctions have typically lasted until midnight or the early morning hours which has been difficult for exhibitors/parents and buyers. We know this decision will be met with varying emotions from folks glad they didn't have to drive back for the sale and spend more on fuel, meals and lodging; and there will be those who would prefer the status quo with the opportunity to walk the sale. Please know we want to do what we feel is best for our exhibitors and our buyers. Therefore, we will be starting the Goat and Poultry Auctions earlier. In turn, the Lamb and Barrow Auctions will start earlier and we are reducing the lots required to walk through the following Lamb and Barrow Auctions by 56 and 92, respectively. This should allow the auctions to conclude at a more reasonable time. We are not reducing the number of animals that qualify for the sale. The "non-walking" lots will receive a minimum base amount plus any add-ons received similar to all other lots in the auction. All sale lots will be subject to potential allocations of any surplus revenue at the conclusion of all of our Junior Livestock Auctions. Again, we know there will be differing opinions on this decision, but we expect the end result to be an overall positive for the exhibitors, buyers and the Show as a whole.
 - SALE LOTS: Refer to each individual species' Special Rules to determine how many placings from each class will make the sale. 1,012 lots will sell: 35 pens of broilers, 35 turkey hens, 15 turkey toms, 108 goats, 254 lambs, 346 barrows and 219 steers.
 - ATTENDANCE:
 - WALKING LOTS: All walking, sale-making exhibitors are encouraged to be present on Sale Day.
 Substitute exhibitors will be allowed with proper paperwork submitted through the Competitive Events Office.
 - o NON-WALKING LOTS: Youth exhibitors with non-walking, sale-making lots do not attend the auction. A guaranteed-base amount of \$1,500 will be awarded to each exhibitor of non-walking lots along with any funds generated through the Add-On Portal for that respective lot.
 - Junior Market Lamb Auction All exhibitors with 7th through 9th place lambs are non-walking lots.
 - Junior Market Barrow Auction All exhibitors with 5th through 6th place barrows are non-walking lots.
