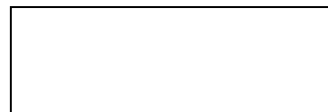

<p>Safety Operation – Familiarity with Controls <i>Identify who is driving – Exhibitor or Other</i> Unloading Procedures will impact Safety and Mechanical Points for tractor even if performed by Other</p>		<p>Circle - Identifying Driver <u>Exhibitor</u> or <u>Other</u> – Teacher, Parent etc.</p>
<p><b>Prior to Unloading the following must be approved</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Truck drivers, exhibitors or representatives <b>must contact Unloading/Loading Officials</b></li> <li>• If there are other projects on the trailer, the driver may be instructed to unload non-tractor projects first</li> <li>• Get instructions from the unloading official for parking and unloading</li> <li>• Person driving tractor to unload and load must be experienced and APPROVED by leader – AST or CEA</li> <li>• Wait for safety checks and approval before unloading the tractor</li> <li>• <b>TRACTOR MUST BE DETERMINED SAFE BY JAM OFFICIAL PRIOR TO UNLOADING –</b></li> </ul>		
<p><b>Safety Checks to be performed by Inspector</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All ramps used in loading/unloading tractors <b>RAMPS MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE TRAILER</b> (3 ramps required for tricycle tractors)</li> <li>• <b>Only Authorized Personnel will be permitted in the unloading area</b> (JAM Personnel, Teachers, Authorized Operators)</li> <li>• No Obstructions during the unloading of tractors (<i>tool boxes, show supplies, unauthorized personnel</i>)</li> <li>• Cooperation from drivers, authorized representatives, instructors, and/or parents is expected.</li> <li>• Tire Inflation &amp; Treatment (no tire black on tread)</li> <li>• Clutch Free Travel - smooth engagement</li> <li>• Safe Operating Brakes – Determine if R &amp; L brake pedals should be locked</li> <li>• Normal Governor Action – idles when necessary</li> </ul>		<p>Judges will evaluate written comments for both Safety and Mechanical</p> <p>LF _____ RF _____ LR _____ RR _____ Tire Pressure - Safety Consideration</p>
