- <u>Personal Narratives:</u> should be limited to 200-400 words, <u>typed</u>. A well written autobiography can often be the deciding factor among highly ranked candidates. Within your narrative briefly discuss one of the topics below:
 - Describe your future college plans, and how/why you arrived at that decision; or
 - Explain your choice of college and if/how a specific person, event or situation impacted your decision.
