## **Breeding Beef Cattle**

American System of Judging Entry Fee: \$15.00 per entry

#### Guidelines:

- 1. California cattle of all breeds must be from a herd that is not affected with Tuberculosis or Brucellosis. Females 24 months of age or older on opening day of the fair must have a calf at side or show obvious signs of pregnancy.
- 2. Exhibitors must be the Bonafede owners of cattle and registration papers must show them as such not less than 30 days prior to the fair. Bill of sale or birth records showing exhibitor-bred heifer must verify ownership rules for commercial females.
- 4. Cow/Calf qualifications: The cow and calf must be shown as individuals in their respective age class.

## **Junior Dairy Cattle**

American System of Judging Entry Fee: \$15.00 per entry

#### Guidelines

- All cattle must be from a herd that is not infected with tuberculosis or brucellosis. All dairy females over four months of age must bear evidence of official calf hood vaccination against brucellosis. Senior and Junior Yearlings in milk must be shown with two-year-olds in both the individual and group classes.
- 2. Management reserves the right to combine classes if minimums are not met.

## SBCF Dairy Replacement Heifer Program

#### Entry Fee: \$15.00 per entry

1. Must be a breed suitable for commercial dairy milking purposes (i.e.: Holstein, Jersey, or crossbreds)

2. Must be owned by the exhibitor for a minimum of 90 days prior to the opening day of the fair in which the heifer is shown as a yearling. Proof of ownership will be a bill of sale or a signed statement and project book showing the animal was dropped from the exhibitor's cow and raised by the exhibitor.

3. All cattle must be dehorned, from a herd that is not infected with tuberculosis, and bear evidence of official calf hood vaccination against brucellosis.

4. To be eligible to sell your heifer at the San Bernardino County Fair Auction you *must* show your heifer at the San Bernardino County Fair for 2 years – 1<sup>st</sup> year as a yearling and 2<sup>nd</sup> year as a bred heifer. It is preferred that the heifer is due to freshen at or around fair time.

5. Sale heifers must have proof of pregnancy age as verified by a licensed veterinarian or fair management designee.

6. Exhibitors may only sell 1 heifer per year in the San Bernardino County Fair Auction.

7. In the event that the heifer freshens during the fair and before the auction, the heifer and calf will be sold as a pair.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 per Entry per Class

#### Guidelines:

- 1. Sow, Junior Yearling or older must have raised a litter of pigs or show obvious signs of farrowing to be eligible for entry.
- 2. All swine must originate in validated Brucellosis and Pseudorabies free herds or areas California is a validated state. Out of state swine must be accompanied by an official health certificate confirming validated status of the herd or area of origin.
- 3. Gilts entered in the market hog division may not be entered in the breeding division or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the Fair.
- 4. Management reserves the right to combine &/or split divisions for the good of the show. Divisions may change after entries close.
- 5. All boars must be detusked!

**Division 510—Swine- All Registered Breeds**

## **Commercial / Unregistered Boars/Females**

## Breeding Sheep Show

American System of Judging Entry Fee: \$15.00 per Entry per Class

- 1. Flock numbers shall be used to identify all entries. Numbers shall be used on regular and practical tags attached to the ear or tattooed in the ear. An exhibitor may not use the same flock number on more than one animal during any two consecutive calendar years.
- 2. Registration numbers may not be used as flock numbers. Ring assistants must be properly attired in an appropriate uniform (4H, FFA or show whites).
- 3. Management reserves the right to combine divisions if any division has three exhibitors or less with less than ten animals total in the division.
- 4. Management reserves the right to add divisions if any breed has three exhibitors or more and ten or more animals.

## Junior Dairy Goats

American System of Judging Entry Fee: \$15.00 per Entry per Class

Please list Breed on the Entry. Show divisions will be determined after entries close.

- 1. This is a NOT Sanctioned ADGA show. It is open to purebred does registered with ADGA or AGS.
- 2. ADGA rules shall govern this show. Junior and senior shows are not separately sanctioned.
- 3. Animal's name must be listed in the entry
- 4. Must list the animal's ear or tail tattoos on entry.
- 5. Only original ADGA or AGS registration certificates will be accepted at check-in time.
- 6. No stamped duplicates or registration applications will be accepted.
- 7. All leased dairy goats must be under the care of the exhibitor at least 30 days prior to show.
- 8. Any animal leased after April 23, 2021 will be ineligible for the 2020 San Bernardino Co. Fair.
- 9. All leased goats must have ADGA Lease Certificates along with animal registration paper at time of Reg. Paper Check -in.
- 10. Management reserves the right to combine divisions if any division has three exhibitors or less with less than ten animals total in the division.

## Junior Boer Goat Show

American System of Judging Entry Fee: \$15.00 per Entry per Class

### Show Guidelines:

- 1. Rules: The ABGA Rules, California Divisions of Fairs & Expositions State Rules and the local rules of the San Bernardino County Fair will govern the show.
- 2. Age of Animals: Birth dates on the registration certificate will be used to determine class entries.
- 3. Females: Any female over 24 months of age that has not kidded and cannot prove current pregnancy will not be allowed to show.
- 4. Registration: All goats must be registered in the herd book of a recognized association. Recognized associations include the American Boer Goat Association, the International Boer Goat Association, the IBGA and the Canadian Boer Goat Association. The original registration certificate is required. The registration certificate and this show's entry form must be in the owner's name. Information on transfers is not acceptable.
- 5. Breeding: All animals must be registered purebred or percentage blood Boer goats and the registration papers and tattoo(s) or other means of permanent identification that matches the one(s) on its registration certificate or the animal will not be shown. If the animal has a microchip as its permanent identification, the exhibitor is responsible for providing a microchip reader. Tattoo policy will be strictly enforced.
