San Bernardino County Fair Youth Horse Show

General Rules

- 1. San Bernardino County 4-H Horse Show Rule Book and/or USEF Rule Book will govern all classes. **Horse Entries must be done online.**
- 2. This show is open to 4-H, FFA, Grange and any open youth between the ages of 9 & 18 years as of January 1st, 2021, FFA exhibitors show in the 4-H Senior Division or other appropriate division (i.e., green horse, novice rider, etc.). The Open Youth and Grange exhibitors will show in their age division.
- 3. Division with less than 3 entries may be combined.
- 4. Horses must be exhibitor's project animal for at least 120 days (January 24, 2021) prior to the show. Ownership papers and *insurance waiver (*4-H members) must be on file with the county office.
- 5. Horses owned as a joint project may only be shown by one designated exhibitor at an individual show.
- 6. All exhibitors, 4-H, FFA, Grange and Open **MUST** wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet at all times while mounted on a horse. See 4-H Horse Show Rule book for further information.
- 7. All showmanship exhibitors must be in their complete 4-H, FFA or Grange uniform as described below.
 - A. **4-H Western Showmanship**: Uniform consists of white, off-white, black or dark blue pants; long sleeved white shirt with the official 4-H tie or scarf, belt, 4-H hat, western hat or helmet, and boots. Horses to be shown with a halter and lead with or without stud chain.
 - B. **4-H English Showmanship**: Uniform consists of breeches, English riding boots, long sleeved white shirt with the official 4-H tie or scarf, belt, 4-H hat, or helmet. Horses to be shown in English bridle (lead shank optional only when used with a broken mouth piece and must be connected to the bit).
 - C. **FFA Western Showmanship**: Uniform consists of white or dark blue pants, white dress shirt (long sleeves required if jacket is not worn), the FFA emblem must be attached to the left front pocket of the shirt, FFA jacket is acceptable. Western hat or helmet is optional. Horses to be shown with a halter and lead with or without a stud chain.
 - D. **FFA English Showmanship**: Uniform consists of breeches, English riding boots, white dress shirt (long sleeves required if jacket is not worn), the FFA emblem must be attached to the left front pocket of the shirt, FFA jacket is acceptable, belt, and helmet. Horses to be shown in English bridle (lead shank optional only when used with a broken mouth piece and must be connected to the bit).
 - E. **Open and Grange Showmanship**: for both English and Western may wear appropriate Grange Uniform or standard attire. **Western showmanship**: Horses to be shown with a halter and lead with or without stud chain. **English showmanship**: Horses to be shown in English bridle (lead shank optional only when used with a broken mouth piece and must be connected to the bit).

Attire: all other classes may be shown in either above stated 4-H, FFA or Grange uniform or standard horse show attire as defined in San Bernardino County 4-H Horse Show Rule book or in the USEF Rule Book.

Divisions: Exhibitors may not cross-enter divisions (i.e. Novice Rider and Junior)

English Flat Divisions & Western Divisions: Exhibitors may not cross enter divisions

Beginning Rider (walk/trot): Limited to two years. Once having shown at California State 4-H Horse Classic or California State Fair rider must move out of this division. Based on the rider (no age limit). Once a member moves into walk, trot; canter class (this includes English, Western, and Gymkhana divisions or in any judged event) they may not move back into the beginning rider division.

Green Horse: 3-gaited division (walk/trot/canter), Based on the horse, first and second calendar year of showing in any discipline ridden by an experienced exhibitor. Once having shown at California State 4-H Horse Classic they are no longer eligible for this division. Thus, a second-year green horse who has competed at the State Classic the previous year would not be eligible to compete for a second year in the same division.

Junior: Exhibitor who has completed the 3rd grade through 8th grade or who has reached the age of 9 by January 1, 2021

Senior: Exhibitor who has entered 9th grade through 12 grade (or is between the ages of 14 & 18 by January 1, 2021)
