Guidelines:

1. Entry Fee: **\$5.00 per entry per class**
2. All state and local rules apply to this show.
3. All birds **must** be identified by leg bands. Leg band ID must be indicated on entry or entry will be rejected and entry fee forfeited. Duplicate numbers must not be used on birds of the same variety. Bands must be attached before arriving on the fairgrounds.
4. Management is not responsible for errors on entry - make sure you enter correct division and class.
5. Exhibitors must provide water and feed cans for each cage on exhibit. All exhibitors are responsible for the care of their birds. Feed will not be provided.
6. Judging shall be by comparison and in accordance with the latest published American Poultry Association Book of Standards. Decisions of the judges shall be final. Exhibitors or their agents will not be allowed to converse with the judges while judging is in progress.
7. Birds substituted must be same breed, variety, age and sex as the original entry.
8. All crates must be removed from the showroom as soon as birds are transferred to show coops.
9. **Any bird with lice, mites, fleas or arrives at the show diseased will be immediately removed from the fairgrounds by the exhibitor at the exhibitor's expense.**

Note: Fair management reserves the right to combine or divide classes to benefit the show.

Guidelines

1. Entry Fee: **\$5.00 per entry per class**
2. All state and local rules apply to the show.
3. Leg bands **MUST** identify all birds. Leg band ID must be indicated on entry or entry will be rejected and entry fee forfeited. Duplicate numbers must not be used on birds of the same variety. Birds will not be accepted unless properly banded. Seamless bands are recommended, but Poultry bands will be accepted.
4. Management is not responsible for errors on entry form. Be sure to enter correct division and class numbers.
5. All exhibitors are required to feed and water their own birds upon arrival. Feed will **NOT** be provided.
6. Decisions of the judges shall be final. Exhibitors or their agents will not be allowed to converse with the judges while judging is in progress.
7. Birds substituted must be same breed, variety, age and sex as the original entry.
8. All eggs laid during the show will become property of the fair and will be destroyed.
9. All delivery crates must be removed from the showroom as soon as birds are transferred to show coops.
10. **Any bird with lice, mites, fleas or arrives at the show diseased will be immediately removed from the fairgrounds by the exhibitor at the exhibitors expense.**

Note: Fair Management reserves the right to combine or divide classes to benefit the show.

Market Poultry Guidelines

1. Entry Fee: \$15.00 per pen
2. Limit of two entries per exhibitor for Poultry Meat pens and Market Turkeys.
3. Pen is three birds **not** over nine weeks of age weighing between 5 1/2 - 7 1/2 lbs. each.
4. Birds must be Cornish Cross and identified on entry form by leg band numbers. Entries without ID numbers will be rejected and entry fees forfeited.
5. Sales receipt or Invoice needed at time of check-in or birds will not be weighed.
6. Meat Pen consists of cockerels or pullet.
7. All Champion and Reserve Champions will be sold at the Junior Livestock Auction.
8. Birds must be identified by leg bands attached at time of check-in. Numbers must correspond with numbers on entry form or birds will be rejected and entry fee forfeited.
9. Exhibitors must provide waters and feeders for each pen on exhibit. All exhibitors are responsible for the care of their birds. Feed will not be provided.
10. Only Poultry Meat Pens judged to be market and consumer ready (equivalent to Group 1 grade) will be eligible to compete in any and all Championships.
11. **Any bird with lice, mites, fleas, arrives at the show diseased will be immediately removed from the fairgrounds by the exhibitor at the exhibitors expense.**
12. **All meat birds will be weighed in at the time of cooping**
13. All Exhibitors that are 5 to 8 yrs. of age shall show as an independent.
14. **Exhibitors are required to make the processing arrangements and coordinate the delivery to their buyer**
15. **2022 ONLY: The top 20 Market Turkeys & Poultry Meat pens will sell in the sale. Sale order and sale selection will be chosen by the judge.**

Poultry Showmanship

Open to all Junior Poultry Exhibitors

Guidelines

1. Entry Fee: **\$5.00 per entry**
2. Must be pre-entered, entry fees paid.
3. Enter class by exhibitor's age as of Jan 1, 2022
4. Birth date must appear on entry.
5. Only birds owned, fitted and shown by the exhibitor in regular divisions are eligible.
6. Pre-Entry Required. Exhibitors shall be on hand and ready to exhibit at the time of judging. The poultry showmanship contest shall precede the judging of the exhibits in that division.
7. Exhibitors must be in uniform as defined in rules at beginning of livestock section.
