Entry Fee: **\$5.00 per entry per class**

All state and local rules apply to this show.

All birds **must** be identified by leg bands. Leg band ID must be indicated on entry or entry will be rejected and the entry fee forfeited. Duplicate numbers must not be used on birds of the same variety. Bands must be attached before arriving on the fairgrounds.

Management is not responsible for errors in entry - make sure you enter the correct division and class.

Exhibitors must provide water and feed cans for each cage on exhibit. All exhibitors are responsible for the care of their birds. Feed will not be provided.

Judging shall be by comparison and in accordance with the latest published American Poultry Association Book of Standards. The decisions of the judges shall be final. Exhibitors or their agents will not be allowed to converse with the judges while judging is in progress.

Birds substituted must be the same breed, variety, age, and sex as the original entry.

All crates must be removed from the showroom as soon as birds are transferred to show coops.

Any bird with lice, mites, fleas, or that arrives at the show diseased will be immediately removed from the fairgrounds by the exhibitor at the exhibitor's expense.

Note: Fair management reserves the right to combine or divide classes to benefit the show.

Entry Fee: **\$5.00 per entry per class**

All state and local rules apply to the show.

Leg bands **MUST** identify all birds. Leg band ID must be indicated on entry or entry will be rejected and the entry fee forfeited. Duplicate numbers must not be used on birds of the same variety. Birds will not be accepted unless properly banded. Seamless bands are recommended, but Poultry bands will be accepted.

Management is not responsible for errors on the entry form. Be sure to enter the correct division and class numbers.

All exhibitors are required to feed and water their own birds upon arrival. Feed will **NOT** be provided. The decisions of the judges shall be final. Exhibitors or their agents will not be allowed to converse with the judges while judging is in progress.

Birds substituted must be the same breed, variety, age, and sex as the original entry.

All eggs laid during the show will become the property of the fair and will be destroyed.

All delivery crates must be removed from the showroom as soon as birds are transferred to show coops.

Any bird with lice, mites, fleas, or that arrives at the show diseased will be immediately removed from the fairgrounds by the exhibitor at the exhibitor's expense.

Note: Fair Management reserves the right to combine or divide classes to benefit the show.

Market Poultry Guidelines

Entry Fee: \$15.00 per pen

Limit of two entries per exhibitor for Poultry Meat pens and Market Turkeys.

Birds must be Cornish Cross and identified on the entry by leg band numbers. Entries without ID numbers will be rejected, and entry fees forfeited.

Sales receipt or Invoice needed at the time of check-in or birds will not be weighed.

Meat Pen consists of cockerels or pullets.

All Champion and Reserve Champions will be sold at the Junior Livestock Auction.

Birds must be identified by leg bands attached at the time of check-in. Numbers must correspond with numbers on entry or birds will be rejected and the entry fee forfeited.

Exhibitors must provide water and feeders for each pen on the exhibit. All exhibitors are responsible for the care of their birds. Feed will not be provided.

Only Poultry Meat Pens judged to be market and consumer-ready (equivalent to Group 1 grade) will be eligible to compete in any and all Championships.

Any bird with lice, mites, or fleas, that arrives at the show diseased will be immediately removed from the fairgrounds by the exhibitor at the exhibitor's expense.

All meat birds will be weighed in at the time of cooping.

All Exhibitors that are 5 to 8 yrs. of age shall be shown as independent.

Exhibitors are required to make the processing arrangements and coordinate the delivery to their buyer.

2024 ONLY: The top 20 Market Turkeys & Poultry Meat pens will sell in the sale. The sale order and sale selection will be chosen by the judge.

Guidelines

Entry Fee: **\$5.00 per entry**

Must be pre-entered, entry fees paid.

Enter class by exhibitor's age as of Jan 1, 2024

Birth date must appear on the entry.

Only birds owned, fitted, and shown by the exhibitor in regular divisions are eligible.

Pre-Entry Required. Exhibitors shall be on hand and ready to exhibit at the time of judging. The poultry showmanship contest shall precede the judging of the exhibits in that division.

Exhibitors must be in uniform as defined in the rules at the beginning of the livestock section.

Classes

Beginners - Ages 5 thru 8 (No Entry Fee or Premiums, Judged Danish)

Junior- Ages 9 thru 10 years (As of Jan. 1st of the current year.)

Intermediate - Ages 11 thru 13 years (As of Jan. 1st of the current year.)

Senior - Ages 14 years and above (As of Jan. 1st of the current year.)

In case of tie or difficulty in determining the top showmen, the judge may ask exhibitor questions regarding knowledge of the breed, weights, origin, etc.

Small Animal Master Showmanship

The 1st place winner of each of the Senior, Intermediate, and Junior classes will be given the opportunity to compete in the Small Animal Master Showmanship Contest. Each species contest winner must declare to the livestock office at the completion of the show his or her intention to compete in the competitions. If their intentions are not declared, the livestock office will offer the next-placed species contestant the opportunity to compete in the Small Animal Master Showmanship Contest.
