Market Poultry Guidelines

Entry Fee: \$15.00 per pen

Limit of two entries per exhibitor for Poultry Meat pens and Market Turkeys.

Birds must be Cornish Cross and identified on the entry by leg band numbers. Entries without ID numbers will be rejected, and entry fees forfeited. Sales receipt or Invoice needed at the time of check-in or birds will not be weighed.

Meat Pen consists of cockerels or pullets.

All Champion and Reserve Champions will be sold at the Junior Livestock Auction.

Birds must be identified by leg bands attached at the time of check-in. Numbers must correspond with numbers on entry or birds will be rejected and the entry fee forfeited.

Exhibitors must provide water and feeders for each pen on the exhibit. All exhibitors are responsible for the care of their birds. Feed will not be provided.

Only Poultry Meat Pens judged to be market and consumer-ready (equivalent to Group 1 grade) will be eligible to compete in any and all Championships.

Any bird with lice, mites, or fleas, that arrives at the show diseased will be immediately removed from the fairgrounds by the exhibitor at the exhibitor's expense.

All meat birds will be weighed in at the time of cooping.

All Exhibitors that are 5 to 8 yrs. of age shall be shown as independent.

Exhibitors are required to make the processing arrangements and coordinate the delivery to their buyer.

2024 ONLY: The top 20 Market Turkeys & Poultry Meat pens will sell in the sale. The sale order and sale selection will be chosen by the judge.

Beginners - Ages 5 thru 8 (No Entry Fee or Premiums, Judged Danish)

Junior- Ages 9 thru 10 years (As of Jan. 1st of the current year.)

Intermediate - Ages 11 thru 13 years (As of Jan. 1st of the current year.)

Senior - Ages 14 years and above (As of Jan. 1st of the current year.)

In case of tie or difficulty in determining the top showmen, the judge may ask exhibitor questions regarding knowledge of the breed, weights, origin, etc.

Small Animal Master Showmanship

The 1st place winner of each of the Senior, Intermediate, and Junior classes will be given the opportunity to compete in the Small Animal Master Showmanship Contest. Each species contest winner must declare to the livestock office at the completion of the show his or her intention to compete in the competitions. If their intentions are not declared, the livestock office will offer the next-placed species contestant the opportunity to compete in the Small Animal Master Showmanship Contest.
