Citizenship: Personal appearance, attitude, enthusiasm, cooperation with leaders, and fair officials.

Leadership: Responsibilities assumed, willingness to assist fellow exhibitors.

Participation: Attendance at fair activities, placing in showmanship classes, number of entries, and placing in other fair divisions.

Record Book: Completeness and accuracy of records. Record books may be online or paper books. They are not required but do account for 10% of the candidate's overall score.

Nomination forms must be submitted to the Livestock Superintendent no later than noon on the Thursday of the fair. A panel of judges, selected by the Livestock Superintendent, will interview all nominees at 3:00 pm on Sunday, June 1, 2025.
