#### Beef Rules:

1. Absolutely no horns or scurs allowed on cattle.
2. Any heifer found to be bred at any time, including the kill floor, will be disqualified from the show and sale. All awards, premiums, and sale monies will be returned to the fair.
3. Open to Steers and heifers only
4. Heifers are required to have a negative blood test for pregnancy 30 days prior to the fair. Test results must be turned in at weigh-in. Cost to be covered by the exhibitor.

#### Market Beef Scorecard

**Market Ready Beef:** Market Beef is projected to have a sufficient fat deposition to meet the marbling specifications for USDA Prime, Choice, or Select+ quality grades.

**Not Market Ready Beef:** Market Beef lacking evidence of sufficient fat deposition to produce a desirable consumer product. Beef projected to grade USDA Select- or lower.

#### Market Calf Guidelines:

1. Entries must give breed, name, sex, birth date, correct division, and Class.
2. Must be owned by the exhibitor for 60 days prior to the opening day of the fair. Proof of ownership will be a bill of sale or a signed statement and project book showing the animals were dropped from the exhibitor's cow and were raised by the exhibitor.
3. The weight range shall be 250 to 400 pounds. Animals weighing more than 400 pounds will be moved to the Feeder Beef classes and will not be eligible for the Auction...
4. Grooming and show ring requirements will be the same as Market Beef. A show stick is required.
5. Feed: Grain, Hay, and Nutritional Formulas. (Please check the general livestock rules for the nurse animal qualifications.)
6. Market Calves must be a minimum of 50% Dairy.
7. All Market Calves MUST be dehorned and castrated. Dehorned if Heifers.

100% and 50%/50% champions and reserves will now be recognized as mandatory sale; Therefore, they will also allow a + 1 to sell.

### Market Calf Scorecard

**Group 1:** Smooth, deep, thick, and compact, with superior and above conformation.

**Group 2:** Must possess a moderately high degree of the qualities of higher grades, carry less finish, and show more bone and less uniformity.

**Group 3:** Lack finish and are rather leggy and hippy, rough in the shoulder, and light in the round. This group will not be sold at auction.

**Not Market-Ready Lambs:** Good or lower-quality grade with 12th rib back fat range < .16 or > .35; under finished lambs grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cut ability.

### Market Goat (Chevon) Scorecard

**Market Ready Goat:** USDA prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .08 - .12 most desirable, .13 - .22 back fat acceptable, average of greater conformation and cutability.

**Not Market Ready:** Good or lower quality grade with 12th back fat range < .08 or > .22; Under finished goats grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cutability

### **\*Master Showmanship\***

#### **Only Open to Exhibitors of San Bernardino County**

We will offer Master Showmanship Competitions for each showmanship class.

The 1st place winner of each of the classes, in each species, will be given the opportunity to compete in the Master Showmanship Contest. Each species contest winner must declare to the Livestock Office within an hour of their last showmanship competition their intentions to compete. If their intentions are not declared, the Livestock Office will offer the next-placed specie contestant the opportunity to compete in the Master Showmanship Contest.

**The winner of each showmanship class will bring the animal that they used in showmanship to the master showmanship contest. They will not be allowed to use their own animal in the contest.**

#### Livestock Evaluation Contest

This contest is designed to be both a rate-of-gain competition and a carcass evaluation (using the Ultrasound equipment) competition and educational program. Livestock Evaluation is a program to provide junior exhibitors with a learning experience that emphasizes all aspects of production. It is used to evaluate the total product, not just the live animal as it appears on show day. The objective of this contest is to reward those exhibitors who produce an exceptional product through good selection, proficiency through healthy feeding practices, and good livestock project management.

#### **Evaluation Contest Scoring Procedure**

Using data obtained from weighing Beef, lambs, hogs, and goats at 60 days, then getting a final weight and ultrasonically measuring for loin-eye and back fat thickness at the fair, animals are scored for the evaluation contest in the following manner:

#### **Average Daily Gain – 40%**

Calculated by dividing pounds gained by the number of days (60 or 120). Most pounds per day scores highest, 40 points, 2nd, 36 points, etc.

#### **Loin-Eye Size – 40%**

Measured in square inches using actual ultrasound data. Largest scores highest or 40 points, 2nd 36 points, etc. **Fat Thickness – 10%**

Measured in inches using ultrasound data.

In hogs and lambs, the lowest scores the highest, and in beef, the highest scores the highest, or 10 points.

#### **Show Placing – 10%**

Calculated using the show ring placing. 1st place scores 10 points, 2nd scores 9 points, etc.

Entries in the Livestock Evaluation Contest will be registered, weighed, and ear-tagged at the San Bernardino County Fairgrounds, unless otherwise listed, on the dates listed below.

#### **Beef, Sheep, Swine & Goats:**

Fair Weigh-in Day and Ultrasound Evaluation (Official Market Weight will be used) (Check the show schedule).

***Contest Animals will be Ultra sounded as they leave the scale.***

#### Premiums Offered per Class

Jackpot placement percentage depends on the number of entries. The more entries, the more places paid.

#### **Guidelines:**

1. All animals entered in the Market Steer, Sheep, Goat, and Swine division are eligible to participate in this division.
2. All local and state rules apply.
3. To enter, exhibitors must complete the following:
  - A. Weigh animals at the official pre-weigh day
  - B. Weigh-in during weigh-in day.
  - C. Have the animal evaluated by the ultrasound technicians at the designated time
  - D. Show the animal during the Live Evaluation Class.
5. Exhibitors must be present to show their own animal. An official uniform is required.

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6. Placing in this division will not affect the sale order.
7. The specie jackpot monies will be divided between 3<sup>rd</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> place, or further if specie monies allow.
8. **Each class must have at least 5 entries** to receive a payout.
