Ceramics / Plaster-craft / Bisque Guidelines

- All General Information, Local and State Rules apply to the entire Ceramics Department.
- ALL Entries must be submitted ONLINE. No written entries will be accepted.
- Entry fees: 1.00 per entry.
- Due to COVID-19 regulations this will be a VIRTUAL show and ALL items/entries will be judged by Photograph and/ or video.
- Photographs and/or videos must be uploaded at time of entry submittal.
- If able the SBC Fair will look at in person judging for Ceramics Department but this will be determined at a later date and exhibitor will be contact.
- Pairs or pieces with lids, spoons or many pieces placed on a common base will be considered as one (1) entry unless you wish each piece to be judged separately. If you are entering three (3) or more pieces as one entry (I.E. Nativity sets, Chess figures, etc.), a limit of 6 pieces for that entry. You may still enter other pieces in that same class.
- Each entry must be entirely finished workmanship of the exhibitor with the exception of hand modeled or thrown ware. Each piece should have been finished since May of 2019.
- All items/entries MUST weight 25lbs or less.
- Ceramic entries must be a clay product, fired in a kiln at a temperature exceeding 800 degrees.
- Plastercraft entries are not fired and are made from plaster of paris.
- Bisque entries are already cleaned and fired ceramic. You must enter under the proper category. Place a letter "B" on the entry form description.
- Classifications:

Advanced – A person who has engaged in the Art for 11 plus years

Hobbyist/Intermediate – A person who has engaged in the Art for 1 to 10 years

- Backs, lids and bottoms of pieces are to be finished. They may be painted, felted or have felt or glaze when applicable. Inside glazing on dry arrangement pots only will not be required
- Identify each of your pieces by type and approximate size in the entry description.
- If your entry will require a stand or some sort of support, please bring the support item with the entry.
- <u>NO Premiums will be offered. Ribbons Only</u>.
