- ALL Entries must be submitted ONLINE. No written entries will be accepted.
- Entry fees: 1.00 per entry.
- ◆ Due to COVID-19 regulations this will be a VIRTUAL show and ALL items/entries will be judged by Photograph and/or video.
- Photographs and/or videos must be uploaded at time of entry submittal.
- Five (5) prints is the entry limit per exhibitor.
- Each artist may enter one of four divisions:

**Amateur**: a beginning student or an artist who is not selling their work. All college students are encouraged to enter individual or class artwork.

**Professional**: an artist who has sold a painting and/or is a teacher (Once you enter this class, you cannot enter a different class)

Handi-capable: a learning or physically impaired exhibitor

Sculpture: a three dimensional exhibit.
