## Fine Arts Department Guidelines

- ◆ All General Information, Local and State Rules apply to the entire Fine Arts Department.
- ◆ Exhibitor must be 18 years of age to enter in Adult Fine Art Divisions.
- ◆ All entries must be the original work of the Artist and not previously shown at the San Bernardino County Fair.
- ◆ All entries in to Class 13, Computer, Digital Art, can NOT be generated by an AI services and the artist must email the original files (PSD, EPS, AI, etc.) to the Chairperson at [craiglebaron@gmail.com](mailto:craiglebaron@gmail.com) for verification. Any artwork generated by an AI will not be accepted.
- ◆ No "Paint by Numbers". Any art work that was done by a "Paint by Number" will not be accepted.
- ◆ Photographs cannot be used in anyway, even in mixed media, no painting over photos or photos printed on canvas.
- ◆ The Chairperson and Fair Management reserve the right to refuse any submission.
- ◆ **Entry fees: \$12.00 per entry per class.** 5 entries of two-dimensional art and/or 5 entries in three-dimensional, (i.e. sculpture), per exhibitor.
- ◆ The San Bernardino County Fair offers a Theme Ribbon to those artists that depict the theme in their art. **Please indicate "THEME" in the description if you wish to be considered for this award.**
- ◆ All artwork must be prepared for hanging with screw eye and taut picture wire. Properly wired, unframed canvases will be accepted if no staples are showing. All paper entries must be framed under glass. See picture for example of proper hanging.

### Artwork not prepared to be hung will be rejected.

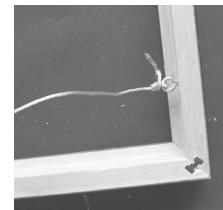
- ◆ Painting not thoroughly dry will be rejected.
- ◆ Exhibits shall be properly labeled on a 3 x 5 card and taped to the back top right-hand corner of each entry (Sculpture – tape info card on bottom of piece) with the following information:

**Exhibitor's name and phone number**

**Title of Exhibit**

**Division and Class numbers**

- ◆ All artists that wish to demo during the fair must submit a resume and photos of their work. Please submit a request with your entry form.
- ◆ Handicapped Division: learning or physically impaired exhibitors may be special education students or disabled citizens. Signature of a Parent or Guardian is required on the entry form. Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 3rd. No cash awards. **No entry fee.** All subjects, all media in Division 302.
- ◆ Each artist may enter one of four divisions:
  - 300 – **Amateur:** a beginning student or an artist who is not selling their work. All college students are encouraged to enter individual or class artwork.
  - 301 – **Professional:** an artist who has sold a painting and/or is a teacher (Once you enter this class, you cannot enter a different class)
  - 302 – **Handi-capable:** a learning or physically impaired exhibitor
  - 303 – **Sculpture:** a three dimensional exhibit
- ◆ Sale of Exhibits: the Fine Arts Department personnel are **not** permitted to make sales or accept monies for any artwork. Interested buyers may fill out an interest form which will be given to the artist. The artist, in turn, can contact the interested buyer on their own.

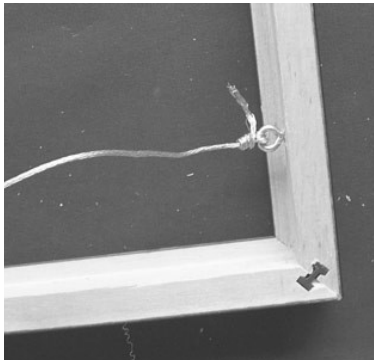
## Youth Fine Arts

### Youth Fine Arts Guidelines

- ◆ Entry fees: \$1.00 per entry.
- ◆ All entries must be the original work of the Artist and not previously shown at the San Bernardino County Fair.
- ◆ Please put **Exhibitor's Name, Age, Phone Number, School, Grade, Division & Class on a 3 X 5 card** taped to the back of your entry in the top right corner, (put the card on the bottom of all sculptures).
- ◆ **Theme:** If you would like to have your entry considered for the "**Fair Theme**" ribbon, you **must** write the word "**Theme**" on your entry form and on the label on the back of your artwork.
- ◆ Art exhibits limited per artist as follows:
  - 5 entries of framed art
  - 5 entries of paper backed with construction paper, mat board or cardboard ready to be hung
  - 5 sculpture entries
- ◆ Entries **must not** have been entered in **any previous** San Bernardino County Fairs.
- ◆ Any piece of Art that depicts any Racial, Bloody, or Gang Related material will not be permitted.
- ◆ **School/Group Projects:** See Divisions 549-556 to enter your School/Group Projects.
- ◆ If you have questions concerning your entry, please contact the Youth Fine Arts Department Chairperson or Co-Chairperson. The Chairperson and/or Fair Management reserve the right to refuse any picture that is not suitable for display. All general information, local and state rules apply to the entire Youth Fine Arts Department.

### Display – Framing

- ◆ **All art must be ready to hang. Art will be turned away and Exhibitor will be given another drop off day if art is not ready to be hung.** The wire on the back of framed paintings must be taut with no wire showing above the frame. See picture for example for proper hanging.
- ◆ **No stand picture frames or clips will be allowed.**
- ◆ All framed paper (not canvas) paintings (watercolor, crayon, graphite, colored pencil, mixed media or acrylic on paper) should have acrylic plastic (Plexiglas) covering the painting. **Glass will be allowed only on pastel & charcoal paintings.**
- ◆ No wet paint.
- ◆ Size limit: Entries shall not exceed 40" (including the frame) in any direction.
- ◆ Original works only. No pre-printed pages (i.e. coloring book pages), except class projects.
- ◆ All entries in to Class 14, Computer, Digital Art, can NOT be generated by an AI services and the artist must email the original files (PSD, EPS, AI, etc.) to the Chairperson at [daddyswidget@gmail.com](mailto:daddyswidget@gmail.com) for verification. Any artwork generated by an AI will not be accepted.
- ◆ No premiums are offered in our Youth Department. All cash and prizes awarded are donated by our generous Sponsors.
