Your packet could include the following: documentation citing past awards or recognition, letters of recommendation, a listing of public appearances, video or audio sample of your performance and website information.

In order to maintain the safety of our guests we require all exhibitors and volunteers to undergo a check against the Department of Justice's Megan's Law Database. If your performance group is selected to perform you will be required to provide personal information to fulfill our commitment to a safe environment for our guests. Failure to complete the paperwork may result in the forfeiture of your invitation to perform.

- This is only an application for an opportunity to perform. Submission of this application is neither a promise by the Sacramento County Fair to provide a performance space or a guarantee of a performance space.
- The parties agree that the participant(s), and any agents and employees of participant, shall act and are acting in an independent capacity and not as officers, employees, or agents of the Sacramento County Fair.
- Upon confirmation participant is required to provide evidence of workers' compensation insurance as applicable. Upon request of the Sacramento County Fair either: (1) participant will provide evidence of workers' compensation insurance prior to commencement of term; or, (2) participant is independent and has no paid or volunteer employees. This certification does not alter or affect compliance with the workers' compensation requirements in the Labor Code of the State of California.
- Participant will waive all claims and recourse against the State of California, Sacramento County Fair, including the right of contribution for loss or damage to persons or property in any way connected to their performance, and shall indemnify and save harmless the State of California, Sacramento County Fair, from all claims due to any acts or omissions.
- Participant shall indemnify, defend and save harmless the State of California, Sacramento County Fair, its officers, agents and employees from any and all claims, suits or actions of every name, kind and description brought forth from, or on account of, injuries to or death of any person including, but not limited to, workers and the public or damage to property resulting from the performance of this agreement, except as otherwise provided by statue. The duty of the participant to indemnify and save harmless includes the duties to defend as set forth in California Civil Code section 2778.
