We appreciate your interest! The cost of a 4-H or FFA animal project is higher than that of a commercial stockman because of the individual attention given to that animal's development. This special attention deserves a premium price, above the market price. The "break even" cost will allow the exhibitors to earn a profit margin that can be reinvested into next year's project or put away for college.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- New Buyers and Returning Buyers can go to <https://sacram.fairwire.com/buyerlogon.aspx> and can sign up as a new buyer or find their previous buyer number and verify/change their information to be ready to buy this year.
- Buyer Check In at the sale begins at 8am and sale catalogs will be emailed to you ahead of time to the email you have on file in the online system.
- To purchase an animal you can do it multiple ways- show up yourself and bid or send someone on your behalf to bid for you.
- For the bidding process you will need to know a few things- What you want to pay for the animal? If that will be Custom or Resale and if its custom which butcher shop you want it to go to. (see specifics below)
- If you are not able to attend the auction someone else can bid for you, you just need to give them all the pertinent information to be able to bid for you and you need to send us an email at dstornetta@sacfair.com letting us know who you are authorizing to pick up your number.
- If you are not interested in buying an animal but would like to support the exhibitor monetarily you may do so by giving them an add on. This is a donation amount that will be added on top of the sale of their animal at the auction. You can do this either on paper which the form is available on the website or you can do it via the online add on page which should be available around May 25th.
- THIS IS A CASH ONLY SALE! We accept cash, checks & credit cards. All purchases and add-on contributions (\$50 minimum) must be paid for at the time of purchase.
- THIS IS A TERMINAL SALE. No live animal can be purchased.

Disposition Explanations:

Resale: The animal will be automatically resold for you at the current market price. You will not take possession of the animal or receive any meat. You are responsible only for paying the difference between your bid and the resale price. The resale price will be calculated using the weight of each animal. For Example:

Lamb (140 lb lamb = approx. 70 lb packaged meat)
140 pounds \$900.00
Approximate Resale Credit *if sold resale* \$112.00
Balance owed if resale (*did not receive meat*) \$788.00
(140 lbs x \$0.80/lb resale value)

Custom: The animal will be processed for you by the butcher (cut & wrap facility) of your choice, after which you will take possession of the meat.
For Example:

Lamb (140 lb lamb = approx. 70 lb packaged meat)
140 pounds \$900.00
Approximate Processing Charge +\$120.00
Approximate Total Custom Charge \$1020.00
