

## Dear Students & Advisors,

The Salinas Valley Fair Heritage Foundation would like to invite all active high school aged 4-H and FFA participants to apply for this year's Heritage Foundation Scholarship and the chance to raise the 2024 Heritage Animal. Along with raising the Heritage Animal, the scholarship winner will receive a \$2,500 scholarship (see requirements below) and several other rewards. We are also offering a \$500 scholarship to the Reserve Winner.

Over the past twenty-one years, the sale of the Heritage Animal has contributed more than \$1,000,000 to the Heritage Foundation. Since the Orradre Building revitalization project has been completed, the Heritage Foundation continues to work on various fair improvement projects. Please consider applying to be a part of the Salinas Valley Fair Heritage Foundation history.

# Basic Student Requirements (see page 2 for complete list of requirements)

- Must be a Monterey County resident and/or be a Monterey County high school student, who will be attending an accredited trade school, junior college, or university.
- Must be willing to raise an animal for sale, with all proceeds benefiting the Salinas Valley Fair Heritage Foundation.
- Submit the scholarship application and three letters of recommendation by November 3, 2023 and attend an in-person interview with the scholarship committee on a date to be determined.
- Act as an ambassador for the SVFHF through the 2024 Salinas Valley Fair.

#### Scholarship Winner Receives

- \$2,500 scholarship (must provide proof of enrollment at an accredited trade school, junior college, or university prior to receiving scholarship dollars).
- Recognition rewards embroidered SVFHF jacket and buckle.
- Reimbursement for expenses related to raising the 2024 Heritage Animal, including animal purchase, feed, and basic equipment (with **prior** approval).
- Heritage membership for the current year– Includes the scholarship recipient, parent(s), and siblings under 21 years of age.
- Recognition in press materials and the 2024 SVF Junior Livestock Auction Program.

#### Reserve Scholarship Winner Receives

- \$500 scholarship (must provide proof of enrollment in an accredited trade school, junior college, or university prior to receiving the scholarship dollars).
- Recognition reward embroidered SVFHF jacket.
- Heritage membership for the current year Includes the scholarship recipient, parent(s), and siblings under 21 years of age.
- Recognition in press materials and the 2024 SVF Junior Livestock Auction Program.



## **Salinas Valley Fair Heritage Foundation Scholarship Winner Requirements**

- 1. Comply with all rules and deadlines of the Salinas Valley Fair per the Entry Guidebook.
- 2. Act as an ambassador for the SVFHF. This includes attending various functions such as the Polenta and Stew Feed in December, the Fair Kickoff in April, and the SVFHF Member Appreciation Night held Wednesday of the Fair. This also includes promoting the purchase of Buyer Gift Cards and encouraging possible future scholarship applicants when attending club meetings or speaking with classmates and peers.
- 3. Attend at least one SVFHF Board Meeting prior to the Salinas Valley Fair to give a 3-5 min. presentation of your project progress. Meetings are held the first Tuesday of each month.
- 4. Create a presentation board or Power Point about yourself, your animal, and your achievements to be displayed in the Heritage Room during the Fair.
- 5. Work closely with SVFHF Treasurer and provide receipts in order to be reimbursed for animal project expenses in a timely manner. Reimbursements are limited to expenses exclusively related to your Heritage Animal Project for the Salinas Valley Fair 2024.
  - a. Maximum limit on animal purchase reimbursement:
    - i. Hogs, lambs, and goats: \$750
    - ii. Steers: \$2500
- 6. Must purchase livestock insurance (cost will be reimbursed). Should you have to use this insurance, the amount you receive will be deducted from the \$2,500 scholarship.
- 7. Write Thank You letters to all Heritage Animal Buyers by July 10, 2024
- 8. Should the Heritage Scholarship Winner's animal not be able to be sold at auction, the Reserve Winner's animal will be used. In that case, the Reserve Winner will receive equal rewards as presented to the Scholarship Winner.
