We would like to take this opportunity to invite you to participate in this year's rodeo parade! The 2024 San Angelo Rodeo will be April 5th – April 21, 2024. **The 92nd annual rodeo parade will be Saturday 04/06/24 at 10:00 a.m.,** and will be televised on KLST/KSAN TV.

The deadline will be 03/29/24 or the first 100 entries, whichever comes first. Please complete the enclosed 2 forms and submit as soon as possible. Instructions for the parade line up, judging, & route are attached. Awards will be distributed to first, second, and third place!

SEE BELOW PARADE RULES:

- Nothing may be thrown, handed out, sold, given away or otherwise distributed from any participant during the parade or along the parade route.
- Anyone displaying the American flag must do so in a respectful manner and must be sure it is secured at all times.
- All drivers must have a valid driver's license in order to participate in the parade.
- The committee and management of the San Angelo Stock Show and Rodeo Association have the right to disqualify any person that does not follow the rules given in this notice, and will be asked to leave the parade route to ensure the safety of the public and the parade participants.
- PLEASE NOTE: A policy regarding political entries has been established by the Board of Directors as follows: Political slogans and banners of any kind will not be permitted in the parade. Only elected officials invited by the association will be allowed to participate as dignitaries in the parade.


PARADE LINE UP AND ROUTE: WAGON & BUGGY

LINE UP INSTRUCTIONS:

All parade participants must be in line and in place by 9:00 a.m. sharp. The judging will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. and the parade will start at 10:00 a.m. Lineup will be at the corner of Concho & Irving, however, unloading will be at the same location as previous years. Wagons will enter off Oakes St. on to Avenue B or Avenue C, just SOUTH of the river. Wagons will proceed EAST on Avenue B to Irving. Parking is available from Avenue A south to Washington Drive, including Fort Concho and the Paseo.

We want everyone to have an opportunity to be included in the one hour time slot of televised air time. PLEASE STAY CONSISTENT with the flow and speed of the parade by staying one car length (or 10 - 15 feet) behind the entry/float in front of you. We want to avoid large gaps in between entries! We appreciate everyone's cooperation in this matter.

- 3. LEFT ON OAKES TO TWOHIG
- 4. LEFT ON TWOHIG, PROCEED TO CHADBOURNE
- 5. RIGHT ON CHADBOURNE TO COLLEGE ST.

- 6. LEFT ON COLLEGE TO IRVING
- 7. LEFT ON IRVING TO BEAUREGARD
- 8. RIGHT ON BEAUREGARD TO RANDOLPH
- LEFT ON RANDOLPH TO RIVER DRIVE & DISMISS
