We continue to lead the industry in our Harris Ranch Natural Beef Residue Control Program and want to be proactive to address other issues. It has become necessary to document that no ruminant meat and bone meal has been fed to any cattle offered for sale to be processed at Harris Ranch Beef Company. The feeding of meat and bone meal was banned by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to safeguard against BSE (Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy) This rule applies to both dairy and beef producers.

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## **Letter of Self-Certification**

I certify that none of the livestock shipped to or delivered to Harris Ranch Beef Company will be adulterated within the meaning of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act (i.e., none of the cattle will have been fed any feed containing protein derived from mammalian tissues, e.g., meat and bone meal, as that term is defined in 21 CFR 589.2000 and none of the livestock will have illegal level of drug residues.).

In addition, I certify that all cattle of Canadian and/or Mexican-origin shipped to Harris Ranch Beef Company have resided in the United States a minimum of 100 days. I will maintain documentation a minimum of 2 years in respective lot files. This documentation provides sufficient information to verify that 100-day minimum requirements (days on feed and/or pasture) have been met for cattle originating from Canada and/or Mexico.

This certificate shall remain in full force and effect until revoked in writing by the undersigned seller and such revocation is delivered to Harris Ranch Beef Company.
