

2023 Adam Lot Camping Policies

- **ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED FOR CAMPERS OF ALL AGES**
 - Any youth exhibitor in violation of this rule will be ineligible to show and sell their animal at the 2023 Santa Barbara County Fair. If the exhibitor has already sold their animal, the money will be returned to the buyer. The exhibitor will be removed from camping immediately. He/she must submit in writing to the Santa Barbara County Fair Board to be considered for reinstated to show and camp at future Fairs.
 - Any adult in violation of the above rule will be removed from Adam Camping
 - Campsites may be subject to cooler checks

- **AN ADULT CHAPERONE (25 YEARS OR OLDER) MUST OCCUPY THE CAMPING UNIT FOR THE DURATION OF THE CAMPING WEEK**
 - Chaperone must be present each night and is responsible for all minors of their unit
 - A maximum of 6 exhibitors per adult chaperone per unit will be permitted
 - Any exhibitor camping without an adult chaperone will be removed and participation in the 2023 Santa Barbara County Fair may be revoked

- **A STRICT NOISE CURFEW WILL BE ENFORCED BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10PM – 6AM**
 - All generators and music must be turned off
 - If you have a special circumstance that requires you to have a generator on past 10PM, this must be approved by the camping committee upon registration. A designated area will be reserved for those that require this accommodation.
 - All exhibitors must be in their campsite and noise kept to a minimum

- **CAMPING SPACES:**
 - Spaces are 20'x 30'. If your camping unit is larger than 20'x 30' you must purchase 2 spaces
 - CIRCILING A GROUP OF TRAILERS WILL BE CAPPED AT 10 CAMPING UNITS
 - Upon registration, each camp group will designate a person responsible for the conduct of the group. This "Camp Captain" will act as the initial point of contact should a noise or conduct violation occur
 - Big groups may be subject to change or split at the committee's discretion
 - Tents allowed as extra sleeping space in conjunction with a self-contained camper/RV
 - Firepits must be self-contained with ash receptacles to prevent burned grass or dumped ashes. Damages will be billed accordingly.
 - No dumping of sewage or wastewater on the ground. Damages will be billed accordingly.
 - Camp spaces will be assessed for damages ie. broken sprinkler heads, garbage, holes dug into ground, etc. and will be billed accordingly to cover City dues
 - **NO DOGS**, pets of any kind, or livestock allowed
 - NO Fighting
 - NO Fireworks
 - NO Illegal Drugs
 - NO Weapons

- **MANDATORY CAMPING MEETING**
 - All campers must attend a MANDATORY camping meeting immediately following the Thursday, July 6th mandatory exhibitor meeting.

- **CODE OF CONDUCT**
 - All campers and guests are expected to conduct themselves in a "family friendly" manner.
 - A strict code of conduct will be enforced throughout the week.
 - Security and Camp Committee members will be monitoring Adam Lot for excessive noise, partying, and violations of any of the rules set forth by this document will result in a citation. If conduct is not corrected, person in violation, responsible adult, and Camp Captain will be submitted to the Livestock Committee for possible revocation of camping privileges present and future.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

- ARRIVAL SCHEDULE
 - Arrival will be broken into time windows
 - Desired time window of arrival will be requested upon registration.
 - Changes to arrival window must be approved by camping committee chair.
 - Arrival times available:
 - Saturday, July 8; 12pm- 3pm, 3pm- 6pm
 - DROP OFF ONLY
 - available at the additional cost of \$100/spot
 - Campers are prohibited to stay Saturday night
 - Sunday, July 9; 7am-10am, 10am-1pm, 1pm-4pm, 4pm-8pm
 - Monday, July 10; 8am-5pm
 - Campers will not be permitted to enter without proper camping pass. Camping pass must be adhered to and visible on the window of camping unit upon entry and for the duration of the week
- DEPARTURE SCHEDULE
 - Departures may begin Sunday, July 16 at 8am
 - All campers/RV's must be completely removed by NOON, Monday, July 17

2023 CAMPING FEES

Single Camp Spot (20'x 30')	\$350.00/spot
Saturday Drop-off Fee	\$100/spot
City Administration Fee	\$25.00
Application Fee	\$10.00

- Each camp spot includes 1 vehicle parking pass for Adam Parking Lot. NO vehicle access or parking will be allowed within the camping fenced area after final arrival time: Monday, July 11, 5pm.
- Camping trailers/RV's larger than 20'x 30' must purchase 2 spots.
- Cancellations can be made by email to reservations@santamariafairpark.com . Deadline to Cancel is June 24, 2023. Refunds exclude City Administration Fee and Application Fee.

REGISTRATION

- Camping will be capped at 140 spots
- Spots are reserved based on completed application and received payment
- Completed application does not guarantee a camping spot
- Registration will open May 12, 2023.

2023 FIRE AND SAFETY REGULATIONS

1. No tents, canopies, or membrane structures of any kind will be allowed within 20' of any open flame device
2. A daily fire inspection of the property will be conducted by the SMFD Fire Inspectors
3. Any visitor found in violation of rules, regulations, standards, or requirements will be issued an immediate correction notice. Failure to comply with correction notice will be grounds for immediate eviction from the area by SMPD
4. Fire extinguishers are posted in the campground per Fire Marshalls regulations. These are ONLY to be used in case of an emergency. Fire extinguishers are property of the Santa Maria Fairpark. Violations and or theft of state property will be subject to removal from the 2023 SBCF and fines will be billed accordingly.
