Class 1

FFA Market Goats 50 lbs.

1st – Itzel Quezada – Orcutt Hill 4-H (Entered in wrong division) – A nice single-entry wether that's good bodied, wide chested and neat fronted. I'd like to square him up at his hock and give him more muscle through his lower twist.

Class 2

FFA Market Goats 74 lbs. – 80 lbs.

1st – Noelia Cruz – Santa Maria FFA – The wether I'm going to go ahead and use to win this class offers a lot of muscle and shape, both up high and down low. He's stout and offers a lot of features in his forearm and foot. He gets a little plainer in his look up front and needs to be smoother shouldered and leveler hiped, but another nice class winner.

2nd – Drea Prescott – Orcutt Hill 4-H (Entered in wrong division) – A tall-fronted, long bodied wether in second that offers a good set to his hip and hind leg. Get right behind him and he just gets flatter ribbed and needs more muscle to compete with the one ahead of him.

Class 3

FFA Market Goats 90 lbs. – 99 lbs.

1st – Ximena Mendoza – Santa Maria FFA – A heavy muscled wether to go ahead and win this class. He looks fresh in the turn to the edge of his loin and good build. I'd like to see him leveler hiped but a nice one to go ahead and win.

2nd – Marlen Salazar – Santa Maria FFA – A wide-topped, long bodied wether that's stout hiped in second. He needs to be squarer at his hock and more correct and laid back in his knee.

3rd – Angela Acevedo – Santa Maria FFA – The wether here in third is level hiped and good looking from the side, really fresh presented and reads with a good shape to the edge of his loin. I'd like to see him stouter featured and bigger footed, as well as read with more muscle from behind.

4th – Stacy Gomez – Santa Maria FFA – The wether in fourth is long-bodied and big footed. He's laid back smooth in his shoulder and comes level out of his hip. Today he gets plainer in his look and needs a shot more muscle from behind.

5th – Miriam Jimenez-Cuevas – Santa Maria FFA – Another long-bodied wether in fifth that reads with some muscle to the outside of his lower leg and shape behind his shoulder. I'd like to see him be smoother about his shoulder, be better in his lower body balance and read with more shape from behind.

6th – Anabel Guerrero – Righetti FFA – A nice one to round out the class. She's wide chested and stout featured being big footed. But ultimately, she gets plainer in her look and shape and reads flat in her muscle from behind.
