To be considered for this program, youth livestock exhibitors apply and send buyer's letters to the community. The student application process is open to all students in 4-H, FFA, and Grange exhibitors in San Luis Obispo County and Santa Barbara County that are officially registered for the Santa Barbara County Fair livestock show. The livestock projects purchased by the 37th District Buyer's Coalition provide locally produced protein for neighbors in need at food banks, churches and shelters.
