#### Belton Lake & Stillhouse Hollow Lake

Belton Lake has long been a Central Texas favorite for water sports, fishing tournaments, camping, picnics or just relaxing. Here, anglers haul in White Crappie, Walleye, Flathead Catfish, Channel Catfish, Bluegill, Sunfish, Largemouth and White Bass. Fed by the Leon River, Belton Lake offers a haven for fishing and boating enthusiasts, covering 12,300 surface acres with 136 miles of shoreline.

Stillhouse Hollow Lake is rated among the highest of Texas lakes for water quality. Fed by the Lampasas River, it covers 11,830 acres and includes 58 miles of shoreline. Open to all, the lake offers many attractive areas for outdoor recreation, water sports, hunting, fishing, sailing or just kicking back. Hiking enthusiasts will enjoy the Chalk Ridge Falls Nature Trail and its scenic waterfall.

#### **Bell County Museum**

For decades, the award-winning Bell County Museum has been a vital resource for the collection, interpretation and preservation of the historical heritage of the Bell County region. This covers prehistory, the land grant period, the formation of the county in 1850, and the establishment of Fort Hood.

The museum was originally housed in the beautifully restored Carnegie Library Building, constructed in 1904. A major expansion in 2006 provided an additional 10,000 square feet of space, which allowed the museum to expand its mission to include providing quality traveling exhibitions such as "The Inspired Line: Selected Prints from Albrecht Durer and Rembrandt van Rijn," hosted in the summer of 2009.

#### The Gault Site: A Wealth of New Archeology Information

The Gault Site has been home to human beings for over 13,000 years. This historically rich ecotone enabled early peoples to

forage the uplands and the stream valley where different kinds of plants and animals were found. To date, the excavations have uncovered almost 2 million artifacts; some of which are from the Clovis period (13,3000 to 12,900 years ago). Bell County Museum is home to a permanent interactive educational exhibit featuring discoveries of the Gault Site. Guided walking tours to this site are available through the museum.

#### **Police Memorial**

As a program of the Chamber of Commerce, the Leadership Belton Class of 2016 raised funds, coordinated design, and worked with contractors to construct a timeless memorial



and entrance sign for the Belton Police Department. This permanent structure not only introduces and welcomes visitors and citizens to the Belton Police Department near the intersection of E Central Avenue and N Birdwell, but honors all public servants who have and are currently serving, and to remember the lone Belton officer, Deputy Albertus Sweet, who was killed in the line of duty in 1881. Visit at any time of day or night.





#### **University of Mary Hardin-Baylor**

The University of Mary Hardin-Baylor was chartered in 1845 by the Republic of Texas. The first building, simply called "The College," was built in 1886, but burned in 1929. The Luther Memorial Arches are the only evidence of that structure and are an important campus landmark today. The University sits on 125 acres in the rolling hills of Central Texas. Enjoy walking through this peaceful campus filled with historic buildings, historical markers, native landscaping, many sculptures and a vibrant student spirit.

#### Musick Alumni Center and Museum

The Musick Alumni Center and Museum at the Parker House on the campus of University of

Mary Hardin-Baylor is housed in the former president's home, which has been remodeled to showcase the rich heritage of the school. The first floor exhibits communicate fourteen of the traditions loved by students and alumni while the upstairs

tells the chronological history of UMHB, beginning in 1845.

The Bell County Courthouse was built in 1884-1885 and is a prime example of Renaissance Revival architecture. Exterior characteristics of the style include a rusticated ground floor with Roman arches and monumental arcaded recessed galleries. The beautiful clock tower and goddess of justice provide an especially dramatic view at night.

FUN FACT: Both Belton and Bell County were named after Peter (I-might-just-be-a-Colonel-but-l've-got-a-Texas-County-named-after-me) Bell.



South Belton Cemetery has two 1936 Texas Historical Commission markers and many of those buried here contributed to the development of Belton, Bell County, and Texas. The cemetery is located approximately one half mile east of the town square at the 600 block of South Penelope Street.



The snack bar sells refreshments. More than 300 family picnic sites and 143 covered picnic shelters, many with barbecue grills are scattered throughout the park. 
#### 4th of July Celebration & PCRA Rodeo

A live auction is held during the evening. All proceeds benefit the Bell County Youth Fair Livestock Show and Rodeo Scholarship Fund.


