JUNIOR CINCH SHOWMANSHIP

All Junior Livestock Exhibitors (excluding Peewee) will be competing for specie overall showmanship in market or breeding classes. Therefore, exhibitors DO NOT need to sign up separately for showmanship. Those selected from those classes will come back for the overall showmanship drive at the end of all market and breeding classes. The overall specie showmanship will then be eligible for Round Robin.

- Only animals entered by a junior exhibitor in the junior department are eligible.
- Exhibitors must show their own animal.
- The animal used for the overall species showmanship lot must be the same animal that was used to gain entry into said lot.
- Exhibitor must be on hand and ready to exhibit at the time called for judging.
- All FFA and Grange member exhibitors must wear the official uniform of their organization while showing their animals.
- 4-H and Independent exhibitors are required to wear new blue or black jeans, and a white collared shirt (short or long sleeved).
- Small animal exhibitors must wear a white shirt with long sleeves.
- Hats or headgear of any kind (unless part of the official uniform) shall not be worn with official show uniforms.
- There will not be any cash premiums issued for showmanship.

Peewee showmanship will be listed in the Peewee section of the Exhibitor Handbook Sections.

The Siskiyou Golden Fair provides an opportunity for Clubs, Chapters, Families or Individuals to enter one (1) backup market animal per exhibitor. If the family has one (1) shared backup animal total, **each exhibitor must enter the backup animal under their name in order for the animal to be eligible and pay the processing fee.** Each exhibitor that chooses to enter a backup animal will pay for a \$5.00 processing fee when entering. In the event that the animal is exhibited in the annual fair, a \$15.00 fee will be collected in the livestock office, a weight ticket will be issued and the animal will be entered in the exhibitor's name that will be assigned the animal.

Backup animals are the only entries that can be moved across divisions and classes.
