Give the agreement to your agent so he or she can obtain your bidder number on the day of the auction.

- > Sunday admission into the fair is free for everyone. In your buyer's packet you will receive two tickets for entrance into the fair on Saturday.

- ➤ Checks are to be made payable to 10th District JLAC. We are accepting **VISA** and **Master Card** again this year to make it more convenient for our buyers
- ➤ The Junior Livestock Auction Committee adopted a <u>Carcass Donation Policy</u> in 2009, information for this program is provided on the back side of this letter.

The 2021 auction sold 235 lots between live and silent auction items and grossed \$1,129,963, we thank you as buyers for helping us to fulfill our mission of promoting agriculture while supporting our local youth. This year the auction committee's fair improvement project was an extension and updated plumbing to the existing wash racks. These projects are costly, but the money left after expenses of the annual auction are put back into the livestock facilities at the fairgrounds for future generations.
