JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION
BUYER INFORMATION

WHO CAN BUY ANIMALS:

Anyone who would like to purchase an animal is welcome to bid at the sale once you have received a buyer's number. All bidding is done on a price-per-pound basis, with the exception of Bred Dairy Heifers, and Bred Beef Replacement Heifers, which are sold by the head.

NEW BUYERS:

If you are a new buyer, please proceed to the "Mobile J&C Auction Trailer" (located across the walkway from the sale ring) to fill out a bidder's agreement and to receive your buyer's number.

ESTABLISHED BUYERS:

If you have purchased with us in the past, a bidder's agreement was mailed to you. Please take your completed agreement to the "Mobile J&C Auction Trailer" (located across the walkway from the sale ring) to claim your number. If you did not receive an agreement, or you have forgotten it, another one can be filled out at the Mobile J&C Auction Trailer. If you have moved or have a new mailing address please remember to update your information.

HOW TO BID:

Raise your hand or your buyer's number to get the attention of the auctioneer or the ring men. The bidding will continue until the top bid is received.

WHEN YOU PURCHASE:

When you purchase an animal you will be asked to fill out a bill of sale. Please stay in the location that you were bidding from, and a representative will bring the form to you. The bill of sale is very important to the processing of your purchase, and must be filled out in its entirety.

You will be given three choices in the handling of your purchase:

1. **RESALE:** If you wish to buy, but have no desire to keep the meat, check the resale box on your bill of sale. The Auction Committee will resell the animal to a packer at market price. The total cost to you is the difference between your bid and the market price. The auctioneer will announce the resale prices for the animals for which the resale option is available. Resale prices will be available the day of the auction.

RESALE EXAMPLE:

You purchased a 250 lb. hog at \$5.00 per pound.	$250 \times \$5.00 = \$1,250.00$
If you want to resell the animal, it would be resold at \$0.49 per pound.	
You would then be billed for the difference.	$\$1,250.00 - \$122.50 = \$1,127.50$

2. **LIVE PICK-UP:** This option allows you to take the animal home live. If you chose to take your purchase home, the transportation becomes your responsibility. Animals consigned for live pick-up will be available for pick-up after 6 PM, Sunday, August 14, 2022

3. CUT & WRAP:

- a. **Sheep & Goat Processing:** You have a choice of two processing facilities this year for cut and wrap services: **Siskiyou Distributing in Yreka and Shasta Valley Meats in Montague.** Cutting and wrapping of your purchase will be by private contract at your own expense. Please note which local outlet you would like to have your purchase(s) sent to. Processing fees for the packing house will be added to your bill. Transportation costs will be paid by the Junior Livestock Auction Committee.
- b. **Steer Processing:** You have a choice of three processing facilities this year for cut and wrap services: **Siskiyou Distributing in Yreka, Shasta Valley Meats in Montague and M5 Butchery in Fort Jones.** Cutting and wrapping of your purchase will be by private contract at your own expense. Please note which local outlet you would like to have your purchase(s) sent to. Processing fees for the packing house will be added to your bill. Transportation costs will be paid by the Junior Livestock Auction Committee.
- c. **Turkey Processing:** cut and wrap services will be provided by **Rockside Ranch in Etna.**
- d. Due to limited carcass transportation from the slaughter house, we will not be able to truck your carcass to any other packaging facility other than the choices given above.

PROCESSING ARRANGEMENTS FOR RABBITS AND CHICKENS ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SELLER.

PICTURES:

You will receive a photo of the exhibitor with their animal compliments of Tri Counties Bank.

PAYING:

All buyers are encouraged to pay for the animal(s) on sale day at the cashier's table at the east end of the auction ring. Cashiers services are provided by Mechanic's Bank. Please make checks payable to the 10th District JLAC. If you prefer, you can also pay with a Visa or MasterCard.

PRICE SUPPORT:

If you don't want to buy an animal, but would still like to support the auction we have the Price Support option. Price Support allows you to boost the price for an individual seller, a 4-H club or an FFA chapter. You can also boost the price of a certain species of animals by the pound, by a flat rate, or all the animals under a certain price. Lastly, you can give money to support the auction in general.
