### JUNIOR MARKET SWINE (9-18 years old as of January 1<sup>st</sup>)

Entry Fees:	\$15.00 per entry per lot
Type of Judging:	Danish

#### **Dept/Class 13-200 Market Swine**

Lot 1 Market Swine, 220-280 lbs

#### **Dept/Class 13-201 Siskiyou County Bred & Born**

Lot 1 Local bred and born market hogs only; MSUT be purchased from a swine breeder in Siskiyou County. Verification must be provided by the exhibitor at check in at the livestock office. Exhibitor **MUST** enter the Market class to be eligible to enter the Bred & Born class.

### JUNIOR CINCH SHOWMANSHIP

Entry Fees:	No entry fee
Limit:	One entry per exhibitor
Type of Judging:	American
Restrictions:	Open to Siskiyou, Shasta, Modoc, Lassen & Trinity counties

- Only animals entered by a junior exhibitor in the junior department are eligible.
- Exhibitors must show their own animal.
- The animal used for the overall species showmanship lot must be the same animal that was used to gain entry into said lot.
- Exhibitor must be on hand and ready to exhibit at the time called for judging.
- All FFA and Grange member exhibitors must wear the official uniform of their organization while showing their animals.
- 4-H and Independent exhibitors are encouraged to wear the traditional 4-H uniform. New blue or black jeans may be substituted for the white jeans. A white collared shirt (short or long sleeved) must be worn.
- Small animal exhibitors must wear long sleeved white shirt.
- Hats or headgear of any kind (unless part of the official uniform) shall not be worn with official show uniforms.
- There will not be any cash premiums issued for showmanship.

#### **Dept/Class 13-210 Swine Showmanship**

## DEPARTMENT 20 MISCELLANEOUS LIVESTOCK

The Siskiyou Golden Fair provides an opportunity for Clubs, Chapters, Families or Individuals to enter one (1) backup market animal per exhibitor. If the family has one (1) shared backup animal total, **each exhibitor must enter the backup animal under their name in order for the animal to be eligible and pay the processing fee.** Each exhibitor that chooses to enter a backup animal will pay for a \$5.00 processing fee when entering. In the event that the animal is exhibited in the annual fair, a \$15.00 fee will be collected in the livestock office, a weight ticket will be issued and the animal will be entered in the exhibitor's name that will be assigned the animal.

Backup animals are the only entries that can be moved across divisions and classes.
