All events will be "Winner Takes All" with each event paying out as follows:

Sousa Ready Mix Quaderator	\$750
Evans Building and Excavating Racing Quad Barrels	\$250
Advantage Paving Ranch Quad Barrels	\$250
Northwest Farm Credit Sled Race	\$500
Banner Bank All Around Redneck	\$500

All prize money will be mailed out after the event. All monetary winners over \$600 must complete a W-9 prior to their payment being issued.

We have attempted to focus on three key objectives:

- (1) to provide safety for everyone involved in the event,
- (2) to ensure that vehicle rules are fair to all participants in the event,
- (3) to ensure this is a fun and thrilling and entertaining event for everyone.

We encourage you to read all the rules carefully and in their entirety. While we have made these rules with safety in mind, we and our agents do not assume any liability in respect to the rules, your application thereof and your safety. We have provided flexibility in areas where, in our opinion, safety is not compromised, nor an unfair advantage created in the interest of ensuring fairness the rules are subject to the interpretation of our event officials and as such may be adjusted to create a balance in the competition. Please remember that any equipment the officials consider not within the intent of the rules will be considered illegal for competition purposes.

EVENT RULES

1. Entry Forms are to be mailed or delivered to the Fair Office (1712 Fairlane Road, Yreka CA 96097) before Wednesday, August 10, 2022. Fees are \$25 per person for the Quaderator and the sled race and \$25 per event for remaining events. All entry fees are made payable to the 10th DAA and are subject to acceptance by the Event Coordinator and Fair Management. Entry is on a first come first served basis and space is limited in all divisions. No entries will be accepted at the back gate and there will be NO REFUNDS.

2. Pit Gate will open at 4:30 PM and close at 6:00 PM. No one will be allowed to enter after that time.
3. It is mandatory that all participants entering through the back gate sign a release of liability waiver.
4. All participants must be 18 years or older.
5. All quad riders must wear a helmet (a full-face mask recommended).
6. Contestants must supply their own Quad.
7. No alcohol will be allowed in the arena or surrounding area at any time. Underage drinking is illegal and will not be tolerated.

Sousa Ready Mix QUADERATOR RULES

1. One (1) passenger will be allowed on each quad.
 - a. Passenger will have a balloon taped to their helmet.
 - b. Passenger must be on their quad to break opponent's balloon.
 - c. Passenger must use a whiffle ball bat that will be provided by fair management. No private bats will be allowed.
2. A maximum of 30 quads will be accepted on a first come basis.
3. Quads must travel in the designated direction.
4. Quads must stay inside the course or will be disqualified.
5. Entry Fee is \$25 per contestant (\$50 per team). Winning team takes \$750.

Evans Building & Excavating/Advantage Paving BARREL RACING RULES

1. This is a timed event. Two stop watches and average will be used for times.
2. Quads will have only a single rider.
3. A maximum of 10 entries will be accepted on a first come basis.
4. Only one run per contestant in each division.
5. Entry Fee is \$25 per contestant. Winner takes \$250.

Northwest Farm Credit COW HIDE/SLED RACE RULES

1. There will be two (2) persons per team (quad rider and sled rider).
2. Each team must provide their own sled.
3. The sled is to be attached to the quad prior to the race.
4. The sled must drag (no wheels) and the two ropes no shorter than 14 feet and longer than 15 feet. If measured by officials and outside the parameters, the team will be disqualified.
5. The sled rider will be placed at the opposite end of the arena behind the designated line.
6. Quad must go around the barrel placed at the end of the arena where the rider is or the team will be disqualified.
7. First team back to the starting line wins.
8. A point is to be awarded towards the All Around to the team for the most originality and creative sled.
6. Entry Fee is \$25 per contestant (\$50 per team). Winning team takes \$500.

ALL AROUND RULES

1. All Around Redneck will be awarded on a points system.
2. Five (5) points will be awarded for a 1st place finish, 4 for a 2nd place finish, 3 for a 3rd place finish and 1 point for all other finishes.
3. In the event there is a tie, the All-Around Award will go to the contestant that entered the most events.
4. In the event two (2) or more contestants enter all the events and were tied on points the All-Around Award will be shared.
