The three stages of bloom are to be displayed in one container supplied by the exhibitor. Maximum container size is 5" w x 6" l x 8" h. Flower frogs, to hold arrangements together, may be used if necessary. Exhibits will be judged on form, color, substance, condition, placement, bloom stage and container.
