- The exhibitor must home-prepare all entries in these classes/lots. Foods must be presented on a paper plate inside a clear zip lock bag or inside a clear plastic clamshell food container (with the exception of decorated cakes). **There is to be NO plastic wrap used.** No entries will be accepted that require refrigeration.
- Quantities for judging are as follows (unless otherwise stated): breads ½ loaf plus 1 slice; mini loaf whole loaf plus 1 slice; muffins/cupcakes/biscuits/rolls/cookies/candy ½ dozen; cakes ½ cake plus 1 slice; pies whole pie. Confections and candy should contain 6 pieces.
