

2023 Siskiyou Golden Fair LIVESTOCK - TURKEYS

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to read and follow all State and Local Rules. Any infraction of these rules will result in forfeiture of all premiums and possible removal from the fairgrounds.

- Rules, definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Official Show Rules and Standards of Perfection of the American Poultry Association, Inc. shall apply to all district and county fair poultry shows except where they are in conflict with CDFA rules and regulations.
- Poultry will not be permitted on the fairgrounds until they have been inspected by the poultry inspector.
- Leg bands are required on all entries upon inspection and prior to cooping at the fair. Duplicate numbers cannot be used on birds of the same variety.
- All portable crates must be removed from the small animal barn as soon as the birds are transferred to the show coops.
- Turkey leg bands will be issued at the poultry inspection.

ENTRY DEADLINE:	Friday, July 21st at 5:00 PM
Restrictions:	Poultry will not be allowed on the grounds prior to the mandatory inspection. Open to 10 th District residents only

JUNIOR MARKET TURKEYS (9-18 years old as of January 1st)

Entry Fees:	\$15.00 per entry per lot
Limit:	Two (2) entries per exhibitor per lot
Type of Judging:	Danish

Division 17200	Meat Pen
Class 1	Meat pen – one bird not over 20 weeks old; Hens 20 to 35 lbs and Toms 30 to 45 lbs.

The Siskiyou Golden Fair provides an opportunity for Clubs, Chapters, Families or Individuals to enter one (1) backup market animal per exhibitor. If the family has one (1) shared backup animal total, **each exhibitor must enter the backup animal under their name in order for the animal to be eligible and pay the processing fee.** Each exhibitor that chooses to enter a backup animal will pay a \$5.00 processing fee when entering. In the event that the animal is exhibited in the annual fair, a \$15.00 fee will be collected in the livestock office, a weight ticket will be issued and the animal will be entered in the exhibitor's name that will be assigned the animal.

Backup animals are the only entries that can be moved across divisions and classes.

JUNIOR CINCH SHOWMANSHIP

Entry Fees:	No entry fee
Limit:	One (1) entry per exhibitor
Type of Judging:	American
Restrictions:	Open to Siskiyou, Shasta, Modoc, Lassen & Trinity counties

- Showmanship is MANDATORY for junior exhibitors entering market classes and must be entered with other livestock entries prior to the deadline.
- Only animals entered by a junior exhibitor in the junior department are eligible.
- Exhibitors must show their own animal and be on hand and ready to exhibit at the time called for judging.
- The animal used for the overall species showmanship lot must be the same animal that was used to gain entry into said lot.
- All FFA and Grange member exhibitors must wear the official uniform of their organization while showing their animals.
- 4-H and Independent exhibitors are encouraged to wear the traditional 4-H uniform. New blue or black jeans may be substituted for the white jeans. A white collared shirt (short or long sleeved) must be worn.
- Small animal exhibitors must wear long sleeved white shirt.
- Hats or headgear of any kind (unless part of the official uniform) shall not be worn with official show uniforms.
- There will not be any cash premiums issued for showmanship.
