

2023 Siskiyou Golden Fair

LIVESTOCK - BEEF

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to read and follow all State and Local Rules. Any infraction of these rules will result in forfeiture of all premiums and possible removal from the fairgrounds.

- Cattle must be halter broke to lead. Runaway cattle will be disqualified and removed from the grounds.
- Cattle must have a double night tie. One tie must be around the neck of the animal.
- All bulls 12 months and older must have a nose lead.
- Bred beef market heifers under 24 months of age must calve by April 30th of the next calendar year. Heifers 24 to 30 months of age must calve by December 31st of the current calendar year. NO heifers allowed over 30 months of age.
- Bred beef heifers must have a second opinion pregnancy check if determined to be open or abnormal by the first exam.
- Bred market heifers are required to have four working quarters.
- Heifers that have unacceptable pelvis area, narrow or small, as determined by the veterinarian will be disqualified.
- California does not require cattle to be Brucellosis vaccinated at this time. It is still highly recommended that heifers entered and for sale receive the vaccination.

Class 1	Market steers – 1100 – 1550 lbs
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LOCAL BEEF SCORE CARD

Market Ready: Market steers projected to have sufficient fat deposition to meet the marbling specifications for USDA Prime, Choice or Select+ quality grades. Market steers deemed Market Ready will be placed and may be sifted on conformation by the official judge.

Not Market Ready: Market steers lacking evidence of sufficient fat deposition to produce a desirable consumer product. Steers projected to grade USDA Select- or lower regardless of conformation.

The Siskiyou Golden Fair provides an opportunity for Clubs, Chapters, Families or Individuals to enter one (1) backup market animal per exhibitor. If the family has one (1) shared backup animal total, **each exhibitor must enter the backup animal under their name in order for the animal to be eligible and pay the processing fee.** Each exhibitor that chooses to enter a backup animal will pay a \$5.00 processing fee when entering. In the event that the animal is exhibited in the annual fair, a \$15.00 fee will be collected in the livestock office, a

weight ticket will be issued and the animal will be entered in the exhibitor's name that will be assigned the animal.

Backup animals are the only entries that can be moved across divisions and classes.

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JUNIOR CINCH SHOWMANSHIP

- Showmanship is MANDATORY for junior exhibitors entering market classes and must be entered with other livestock entries prior to the deadline.
- Only animals entered by a junior exhibitor in the junior department are eligible.
- Exhibitors must show their own animal and be on hand and ready to exhibit at the time called for judging.
- The animal used for the overall species showmanship lot must be the same animal that was used to gain entry into said lot.
- All FFA and Grange member exhibitors must wear the official uniform of their organization while showing their animals.
- 4-H and Independent exhibitors are encouraged to wear the traditional 4-H uniform. New blue or black jeans may be substituted for the white jeans. A white collared shirt (short or long sleeved) must be worn.
- Small animal exhibitors must wear long sleeved white shirt.
- Hats or headgear of any kind (unless part of the official uniform) shall not be worn with official show uniforms.

- There will not be any cash premiums issued for showmanship.
