

2023 Siskiyou Golden Fair LIVESTOCK - GOATS

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to read and follow all State and Local Rules. Any infraction of these rules will result in forfeiture of all premiums and possible removal from the fairgrounds.

- Dwarf goats are considered small animals.
- Market goats must be castrated, disbudded and completely healed by the official weigh date.
- Horn regrowth cannot exceed one inch in length and must be blunt ended.
- Market goats must be less than one year of age and show kid teeth.
- Market goats must be slick shorn to 3/8", but not below the knees and hocks.
- All goats will be vet checked. Market animals will be checked at the scales, all other animals will be checked at their pens. Should there be a problem, the livestock superintendent will contact the exhibitor. Any animals that fail the vet check will be sent home immediately.

The Siskiyou Golden Fair provides an opportunity for Clubs, Chapters, Families or Individuals to enter one (1) backup market animal per exhibitor. If the family has one (1) shared backup animal total, **each exhibitor must enter the backup animal under their name in order for the animal to be eligible and pay the processing fee.** Each exhibitor that chooses to enter a backup animal will pay for a \$5.00 processing fee when entering. In the event that the animal is exhibited in the annual fair, a \$15.00 fee will be collected in the livestock office, a weight ticket will be issued and the animal will be entered in the exhibitor's name that will be assigned the animal.

Backup animals are the only entries that can be moved across divisions and classes.

- All FFA and Grange member exhibitors must wear the official uniform of their organization while showing their animals.
- 4-H and Independent exhibitors are encouraged to wear the traditional 4-H uniform. New blue or black jeans may be substituted for the white jeans. A white collared shirt (short or long sleeved) must be worn.
- Small animal exhibitors must wear long sleeved white shirt.
- Hats or headgear of any kind (unless part of the official uniform) shall not be worn with official show uniforms.
